- Headphones must be worn when listening to audio material (the library does not provide these).
- We accept no responsibility for the validity or quality of information available via the internet and cannot vouch for the security of internet sites, therefore any financial transactions are undertaken at your own risk. Library staff are not permitted to undertake any transactions on customers behalf.
- You must not deliberately access any sexually explicit, racist or other offensive material. It shall be at the discretion of Hartlepool Borough Council as to what constitutes offensive material. A filtered service is provided, but this cannot guarantee complete protection from offensive material.
- Staff may terminate a computer session if these conditions of use are broken, or if the Library byelaws are contravened. Hartlepool Borough Libraries reserve the right to suspend or ban any user from access to the WiFi Service.
