

Governor Induction Training

Now you are a Governor

School governors play an important role in the running and management of schools providing strategic leadership, guidance and support. Governors need to have a detailed understanding of how their school works and what is expected of them to help their school achieve success. This knowledge is built up over time through attendance at meetings, visiting the school, discussions with the headteacher, staff and other governors and by attending training events and local authority briefings.

This essential training for new governors will help you to gain a better understanding of the role of school governors by explaining:

- The key duties of the governing body
- The Governors Code of Conduct
- The do's and don'ts of being a governor
- Governors' responsibilities around finance and staffing

Whilst aimed primarily at new governors other governors are welcome to attend to refresh their knowledge and share their experience.

Tuesday 15th November - 9.30 am to 11.30 am
