UNACCEPTABLE WAYS TO TETHER



DO NOT USE ROPE/NYLON



DO NOT TIE HORSES DIRECTLY TO TREES/FENCES/LAMP POSTS



DO NOT ALLOW HORSES TO GET CAUGHT UP IN TREES

THE LOCATION MATTERS



DO NOT LET HORSES GET TOO CLOSE TO THE ROAD/RIGHTS OF WAY



LOOSE HORSES BY A ROAD ARE DANGEROUS



UNSUITABLE AND POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS ENVIRONMENT

CONDITION OF THE HORSE



POOR AREA – HORSES MUST HAVE FOOD



IF INJURED, OWNERS MUST CALL THE VET



TIGHT HEADCOLLARS AND COLLARS CAUSE INJURIES

BE AWARE



DO NOT TETHER NEAR RAGWORT



DO NOT TETHER MARES WITH A FOAL AT FOOT
