M Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 9)

We will be using fully trained security personnel (Hartlepool United Marshals).

Age and Bag checks will be carried out on visitors attending the festival.

We will be operating a zero tolerence policy.

Children must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times. There will be a lost and found procedure in place for the duration of the event.

Event and Music will cease at 10.00 pm, whereafter crowds will be directed to the designated festival exits.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Fully trained security personnel will be stationed at all entrances, exits and vip areas as well as throughout the festival grounds. We will be operating a zero tolerance policy. Anyone caught with, taking, handling or selling illegal substances will be detained by security staff and handed over to police. There will also be a rapid response security team camera equipped to deal with any eventuality. Age checks and bag checks will be carried out on people entering the festival site.

c) Public safety

It is expected that the event for which the licence is required will be subject to a full Safety Advisory Group process and as such a full Event Safety Management Plan will be produced to address any concerns raised over public safety, identify risks to this safety and supply information and plans related to operational procedures should a threat to public safety arise. We intend to employ an independent Health and Safety Officer to carry out this task.

There will be first aid facilities on site, details will be outlined in the Event Safety Management Plan.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Event hours are from 11.00 am with event closing at 10.00 pm. main stage will end at 10.00 pm and crowds dispersed peacefully thereafter. Noise levels will be monitored by the on site stage and production team at the nearest noise sensetive premises and adjusted accordingly should they exceed designated and agreed levels.

e) The protection of children from harm

All children 16 and under must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times. I.D. and age checks will be carried out, we intend to operate a challenge 21 policy on all event bars A lost and found childrens procedure will be outlined in the Event Safety Management Plan. All Security and Volunteer staff will be required to have a valid CRB/DBS certificate.
