Online Applications

From September 2017 you can apply for a secondary school place online at **www.hartlepool.gov.uk/schooladmissions** then click on the link for online admission applications.

There are lots of benefits of applying online:

- It's quick and easy to use
- You can apply 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- There's no risk that your application will be lost in the post
- It's safe and secure
- You will get your decision quicker than parents who submit by paper application form.

Who makes the application?

The person who has parental responsibility should submit the application for the child's school place. If parents are separated and both have parental responsibility, please ensure that you both are involved in the application process. If you need further advice about who should apply for your child's school place, please contact the Admissions Team on 01429 523768.

Once I've made an application, and submitted it, can I change my preferences or submit other information?

You can make changes to your application up until the National closing date ie 31st October 2017. Every time you make a change to your online application you will receive an e-mail confirming the status of your application. You can also check the status of your application when you log in to the system and select your existing records.

What do I need to do to apply online?

You need access to a computer and an e-mail account.

What if I can't apply online?

Please contact the Admissions Team (contact details below) to obtain a paper copy of the application form. Please do not apply online and complete the paper application form. The closing date for applications is 31st October 2017.
