Online Applications

From 13th November 2017 you can apply for a primary school place online at www.hartlepool.gov.uk/schooladmissions then click on the link for online admission applications.

There are lots of benefits of applying online:

- You can apply 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- There's no risk that your application will be lost in the post
- It's safe and secure, and quick and easy to use
- You will get your decision quicker than parents who submit by paper application form.

Who makes the application?

The person who has parental responsibility should submit the application for the child's school place. If parents are separated, and both have parental responsibility, please ensure that you are both involved in the application process. If you need further advice about who should apply for your child's school place, please contact the Admissions Team.

Once I've made an application, and submitted it, can I change my preferences or submit other information?

You can make changes to your application right up to the closing date. Every time you make a change to your online application you will receive an e-mail confirming the status of your application. You can also check the status of your application when you log in to the system and select your existing records. Always make sure you re-submit each time you revisit your application.

What do I need to do to apply online?

You need access to a computer and an e-mail account.

What if I can't apply online?
