

Tees Valley Joint Minerals and Waste Core Strategy DPD and Policies and Sites DPD

The five Tees Valley local authorities, Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough, Redcar and Cleveland and Stockton-on-Tees, have prepared Joint Minerals and Waste Development Plan Documents (DPDs). The Minerals and Waste Core Strategy DPD contains the long-term spatial vision and strategic policies needed to achieve the key objectives for minerals and waste developments. The Minerals and Waste Policies and Sites DPD will identify specific sites for future minerals and waste development and provide a limited range of policies which will be used to assess minerals and waste planning applications. The DPDs will cover the whole of the boroughs of Darlington, Hartlepool, Middlesbrough and Stockton-on-Tees and that part of Redcar and Cleveland Borough which lies outside the North York Moors National Park. These DPDs, when adopted, will form part of each authority's Local Development Framework and cover the period until 2026.

The Minerals and Waste Core Strategy DPD was submitted to the Secretary of State on 12 November 2010 and the Minerals and Waste Policies and Sites DPD was submitted to the Secretary of State on 15 November 2010. This began the public examination process which will ensure they are sound and can be adopted by the authorities. The DPDs, all other relevant documents and all of the representations which were received following the Publication stage (August 2009) and the Proposed Changes stage (August 2010) will be considered during this public examination.
