# **Extra Care Housing**

## What is extra care housing?

Extra care housing is **self-contained flats or bungalows in a communal complex**. Each property has their own kitchen, bathroom, bedroom(s) and living areas. There are **care staff available on site 24/7** for people who need care and support.

Although all our extra care housing schemes vary in their design they all have some **communal facilities** and organised social activities.

Communal facilities can include:

- A shop
- A café and/or restaurant
- A communal lounge
- A fitness suite or gym
- A hair salon
- Landscaped gardens

The aim of extra care is to help support people to be as independent as possible and live in their own property for as long as possible.

Moving into extra care housing can be a positive step for people who either have care or may need care in the future as there is care available on site which can change to suit your needs over time.

## » Extra Care Housing Schemes

There are five extra care schemes in Hartlepool.

- Albany Court, Bamburgh Court, Richard Court are only available for social rent
- Hartfields and Laurel Gardens have mixed tenure properties. This means there are properties for social rent and also part or full ownership.

## » Applying for housing for older people

To be eligible for extra care housing you need to be a minimum of:

- 55 years old with a care/support need, or
- 60 years old with no care/support needs
- There are a small number of properties available for people with a learning disability
