# SERVICES FOR PEOPLE WHO ARE VISUALLY IMPAIRED



This factsheet provides information about services if you are visually impaired.

An individual, parent or family may require assistance in order to access a particular service, such as talking newspapers, support groups or loaning equipment for use at school, home or work.

Hartlepool Borough Council provides a specialist service for people of all ages who are visually impaired and who have been assessed as being eligible for services.

Help may be offered in the following areas:

- Mobility: to enable people to get around, become familiar with new territory and learn routes which they need to use regularly.
- Communication: to reach an individual a skill which will assist them to record and read information.
- Daily Living Skills: to practice tasks which are performed regularly such as making a drink or a snack.

### **Blind Welfare Association**

The Hartlepool Blind Welfare Association is a registered charity concerned with the welfare of visually impaired people of all ages living in Hartlepool.

The Blind Welfare Association gives support and information on all aspects of living with a visual impairment.

The Blind Welfare Centre is on Avenue Road opposite the Police Station. It is open Monday to Thursday from 9am to 5pm.
