Borrowdale Street Closure

Description

The Belle Vue Residents Association and Foggy Furze Ward Councillors over the last three years raised ongoing concerns relating to the Belle Vue Estate in relation to crime and disorder and particularly the use of Borrowdale Street as a cut through. Therefore it is proposed that pedestrian and vehicle access to Borrowdale Street from Windermere Road will be prevented through the installation of an 8 foot freestanding metal fence and alley gate constructed with 358 security mesh. The fence would be installed at the bottom of Borrowdale Street, from 21 Windermere Road, across the existing pavements and highway, over to 15 Windermere Road. An alley gate will also be installed to enable the occupant of 15 Windermere Road to continue to have access to their garage door which would be located behind the new fence line.

Nature of Delegation being Exercised

To consult on the prevention of vehicle and pedestrian access to Borrowdale Street from Windemere Road in line with the provisions of Section 59 of the Anti-social Behaviour and Policing Act 2014 (Public Space Protection Order) and local Planning and Traffic Regulation Orders.

Decision

To proceed with the statutory consultation requirements as outlined.

Reason for Decision

To address concerns raised by the local community and ward councillors in

relation to crime and disorder.

Alternative Options Considered

A number of options have been considered however initial consultation with local residents, ward councillors and other interested parties such as utility providers indicates that the solution outlined above is the preferred option subject to the outcome of statutory consultations.
