The following information provides details on how we may collect, use and where appropriate share personal information in relation to planning in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR). It should be read in conjunction with the Council's privacy notice document.

We will collect, store and use the following categories of personal information about you:		
Your name		
 Contact details such as address, telephone numbers and e-mail addresses. 		
Any specific needs that need to be taken account of in the event of an emergency		
We will collect information categorised as sensitive in order to carry out our legal obligations and in line with our data protection policy.		
This may include information such as health support needs.		
We collect personal information by letter, email, telephone, online and through face to face contact with you or, on occasion, an agreed representative appointed by you.		
Most commonly, we will use your personal information in the following circumstances:		
 processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller. 		
processing is necessary in order to protect the vital interests of the data subject or of another natural person.		
 the data subject has given consent to the processing of his or her personal data for one or more specific purposes.
