The following information provides details on how we may collect, use and where appropriate share personal information in relation to planning in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR). It should be read in conjunction with the Council's privacy notice document.

Why we collect your information		Hartlepool Borough Council will collect your personal information for the purposes of consulting, determination and enforcement of planning applications planning enforcements and planning related matters	
2.1	What information do you collect about me?	We will collect, store and use the following categories of personal information about you:

2.1	Will you collect more sensitive personal information about me?	We do not routinely collect information categorised as sensitive, however we may be supplied with information as part of an application or subsequent consultation. Were we are supplied with this information it will be processed only to carry out our legal obligations and in line with our data protection policy	
2.2	How will you collect personal information about me?	We collect personal information by letter, email, telephone, online and through face to face contact with yourself, or on occasion an agreed representative of you, appointed by yourself.	
2.3	How will the Council use the information it	Most commonly, we will use your personal information in the following circumstances:

2.5 What if I don't want to provide the Council with my personal information?	Unfortunately if you do not provide the information as described above we will be unable to process your planning application or comments submitted in association with an application.		
3.1 Will you share my personal information with third parties?	It may be necessary to share your information with other third partied organisations in order to consider your application or comments or enforcement of conditions and obligations. These may include:		
	• <b>interested parties</b> (eg members of the public) via the Council's planning portal, which will allow them to view details supplied (subject to redaction) and comment on an application.		
	<ul> <li>other third party organisations (eg utilities companies) who may also be consulted where required.</li> </ul>		
3.2 Which third parties process my personal information?	<ul> <li>The following third party organisations may process information about you:</li> <li>Northgate Public Services – The Council's IT provider Northgate may have to access the system on occasions where there is a fault and who provide the Council's planning system.</li> <li>Other organisations – who may be consulted on planning applications or enforcement matters.</li> </ul>		
How long will you keep my data	We will only retain your personal information for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes we collected it for, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements. Details of retention periods for different aspects of your personal information are available in our retention policy which is available from <u>www.hartlepool.gov.uk/retention-</u> <u>schedules</u> .
