Following the success of last year's Hartlepool Waterfront Festival, which welcomed over 15,000 visitors across the weekend, we are excited to announce another packed programme of open-air performances, immersive experiences, family-friendly activities and art installations.

This year's theme is 'Harbour of Refuge' – historically, this was the name of a safe haven for ships seeking free shelter from stormy seas. The founder of the town, Ralph Ward Jackson spent most of his life raising money to build a Harbour of Refuge here in Hartlepool. The Harbour of Refuge was never built due to a lack of funds.

The time has come to complete his vision and build the re-imagined Harbour of Refuge at this year's festival.

Join us to re-interpret this concept and celebrate the good old Hartlepool welcome given to those from different communities seeking a better life, through an imaginative line-up of music, theatre, community arts and creative activities as we throw a giant two-day welcome party for a 25 foot tall puppet!


#### **Wintertide Festival**




#### **Pantomime Beauty and the Beast**
