Notes

1. A Family Entertainment Centre Gaming Machine Permit authorises the holder of the permit to make available an unlimited number of Category D gaming machines at the named premises. No other category of gaming machine may be made available.
2. An application may be made only by a person who: -
 - a) Occupies or proposes to occupy the premises, and
 - b) Proposes to use the premises as an unlicensed family entertainment centre.
3. If the applicant for a permit is an individual, he must be aged 18 or over.
4. An application for a permit may not be made if a premises licence has effect in respect of the premises.
5. The fee to accompany an application for a permit is: -
 - £100 for an existing operator. This means someone who currently holds a Section 34 permit issued under the Gambling Act 1968 for the premises to which the new application relates.
 - £300 for a new application where no Section 34 permit is currently in force.

Cheques should be made payable to Hartlepool Borough Council

6. The submission of an application and payment of a fee does not guarantee that a permit will be granted. Applicants should await notification from Hartlepool Borough Council before engaging in activities to which the permit relates.
7. If granted, the permit shall have effect for a period of ten years beginning with the date on which the permit takes effect.
