Notes for Guidance

 practicable you must provide a statement with this notice, explaining the reasons for not
 providing the licence.
- 2. If you are not the Premises Licence holder you must also (within 48 hours of giving this notice to the licensing authority) give the holder of the Premises Licence:
 - (i) A copy of this notice and
 - (ii) Notice that he must send the Premises Licence to the licensing authority within 14 days. If this is not practicable he must provide a statement explaining the reasons for not providing the licence.
- 3. No fee is required to be submitted with this notice.
- 4. If you are the Premises Licence holder you are advised that <u>no</u> supply of alcohol may be made until a new designated premises supervisor has been appointed for the Premises Licence.
- 5. Every supply of alcohol made under the terms of your Premises Licence must be made or authorised by a designated premises supervisor who holds a valid personal licence.
- 6. If you are the Premises Licence holder you are advised that you must formally apply to this licensing authority to have a new designated premises supervisor installed, in order to continue to supply alcohol.
- 7. A person commits an offence if he fails, without reasonable excuse, to comply with any direction given to him in 2 above.
