Subject / Description & Reason for Decision:	Property – Sale of Rockhaven, 36 Victoria Road, Hartlepool
	The property, as shown in the attached plan, has been vacant for over two years and is deemed to be surplus to operational requirements. Whilst being marketed by an external agent since January 2019 a number of offers were been received which have either been too low or have never come to fruition. The present offer is not only the highest received but is for the creation of various office suites which is considered in keeping with the surrounding area, will reduce vacancy rates and will help stimulate confidence in presently challenging economic times.
	It is therefore proposed that the Council sells the freehold interest of the property with vacant possession to a company, to be yet incorporated belonging to Goldcrest Property Investments Ltd at a price of £85,000. This money will go towards achieving the Council's capital receipt target and will reduce the Council's long term repairing liability for buildings of this kind. The proposed use is for the creation of office suites with the creation of a parking area to the front of the premises off Victoria Road.
