Subject / Description and Reason for Decision:

Grant of Licence to Secretary of State for Housing Communities and Local Government for the construction and operation of a Covid-19 Local Testing Site on land at the Headland Town Square and Middlegate Car Park shown verged red on the attached plan.

The licence terms are briefly as follows:

- 1. Licence Fee: a peppercorn per annum if demanded.
- 2. Licence Period: a period of 6 calendar months beginning on, and including 28th October 2020
- 3. Minimum Licence Period Date: means the date 3 calendar month from and including 28th October 2020
- 4. Permitted Use: use as a medical testing and/or vaccination centre with associated car parking
- 5. The Licensee shall pay a fair proportion of all costs payable by the Licensor for the maintenance, repair, cleaning and renewal of the Accessway and all Service Media, structures and other items used or capable of being used by the Property in common with other land.
- 6. The Licensee must pay all Rates and Taxes
- 7. The Licensee shall keep the Property and, at the end of the Licence Period, leave the Property, clean, tidy and

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clear of rubbish and shall reinstate the Property to no less than the standard reflected in the Schedule of Condition and free from obstruction all Service Media on the Property.

The purpose of the grant of the licence is to allow the provision of a Local Testing Site in the Headland area of Hartlepool to facilitate residents' access to Covid testing during the current pandemic.
