Craft activity – Snake



Materials:

- White card
- Pens
- Straw
- Scissors
- Glue



Step 1:

Draw a circular spiral shape for the body of the snake.



Step 2:

Cut this out following the lines so the body is bouncy.



Step 3:

Colour and decorate with a pattern.



Step 4:

Using the left-over card, draw the snakes face and cut out as shown.

Using this as a template draw a second shape and cut out..



Step 5:

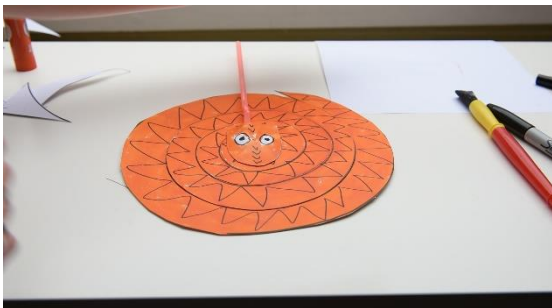
Draw on the snake's face on one piece of the paper and colour in.



Step 6:

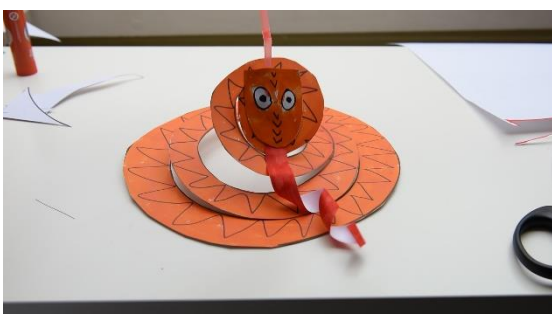
Glue the two pieces of paper together for the face but leave a gap in the middle.

Place the straw in the gap.



Step 7:

Glue the face to the centre of the snake's body.



Step 8:

Using the left-over card, cut out a long strip for the tongue and colour in.

Spiral the paper and glue to the snake's mouth.

Craft activity – Ladybird / Bumble Bee



Materials:

- White paper
- Red/ yellow card
- Lollipop sticks
- Pipe cleaner
- Scissors
- Glue/ Sellotape



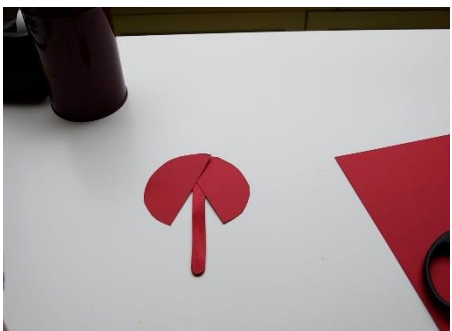
Step 1:

Get the coloured piece of card and draw around a circular object such as a tin of beans.



Step 2:

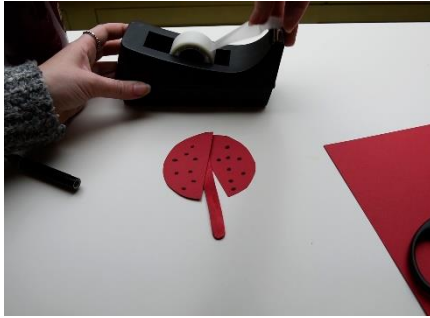
Cut the circle out.



Step 3:

Cut the circle in half to make the body. Rotate the pieces as shown.

Glue to a lollipop stick.



Step 4:

Decorate the ladybird.

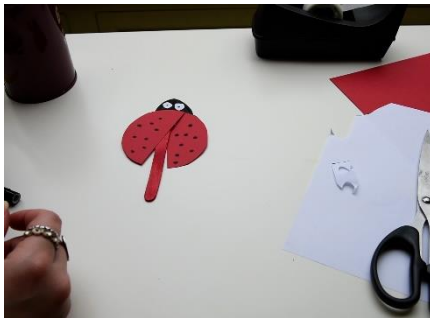
REMEMBER- They have an equal number of dots on each wing.



Step 5:

On the white piece of paper, draw the ladybirds face as shown and colour in black.

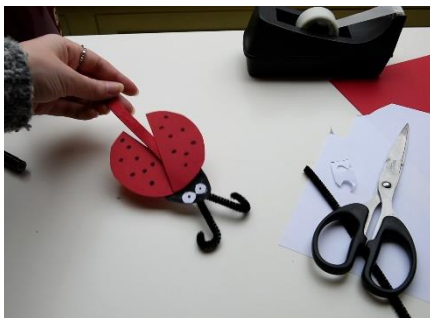
Cut this out.



Step 6:

Glue on the ladybird's face.

Draw two little circles for the eyes, cut out and glue to the ladybird's face.



Step 7:

Cut the pipe cleaner into two equal pieces.

Curl the ends using a pencil.

Glue to the ladybird as shown.



Step 8:

You can repeat this and make a bumble bee with yellow card.

Crafts activity – Silhouette crafts

This activity is designed by Jean Mitchell-Smith (Source: The Piece Hall Learning Zone)



Materials:

- Card
- Felt tips/colouring pencils/crayons
- Paper

Instructions:

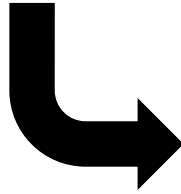
1. Cut out a simple shape from whatever you have to hand: paper, thin card, newspaper, page of a magazine. If you are drawing a symmetrical shape like a butterfly or heart, fold the paper in half and just draw half the shape – then both sides will be identical.
2. Put the cut out shape on another piece of card or paper of any colour and hold it in place. Using any crayons or felt tips start on the cut out and flick the colour onto the background paper. Lift the shape off and you have a silhouette!

Creative activity – Watercolour insects

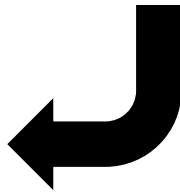
In your pack you will find a range of wonderful insects printed on card, grab your watercolour palette and have a go at painting them.

Creative activity - Optical illusion

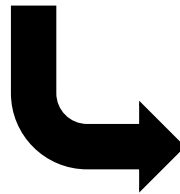
This optical illusion is a really simple one to create. Begin by tracing your hand on a piece of paper



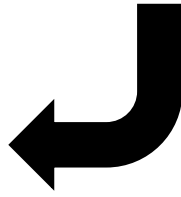
Next, use a ruler to draw straight lines across the paper but not over the hand.



Now, draw curved lines inside the hand to join the lines up.

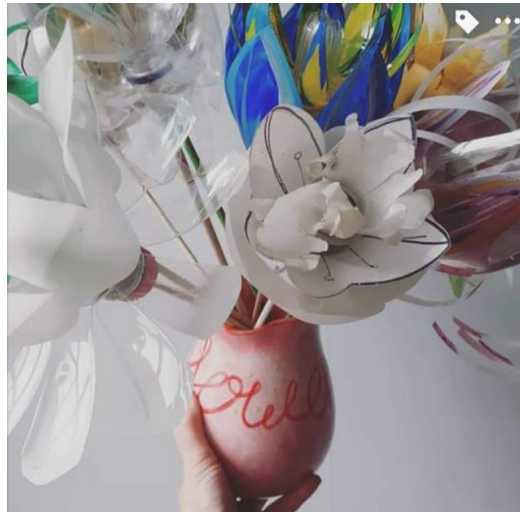


Once the hand is coloured in it should appear as though it is popping right off the page. You could try shading it to make it stand out further.

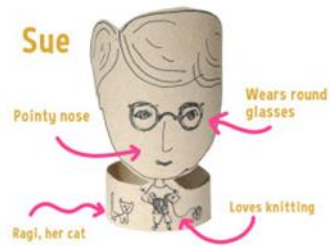

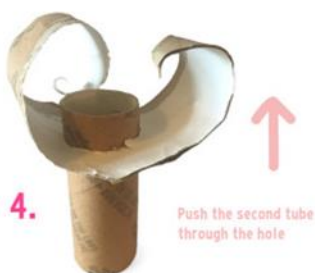

Carefully cut out the tail, remember to leave a bit attached at the side



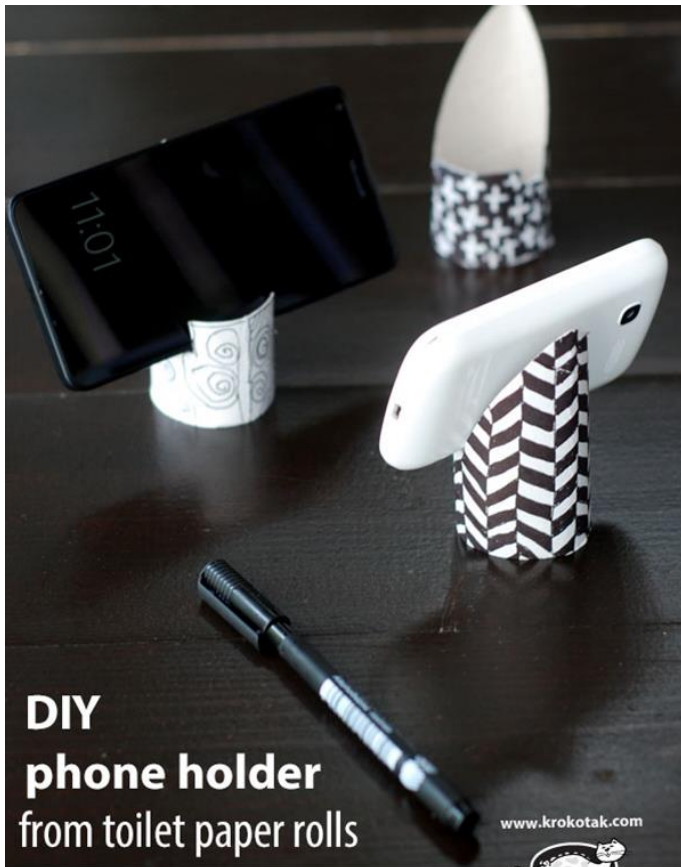

Fill in this template;

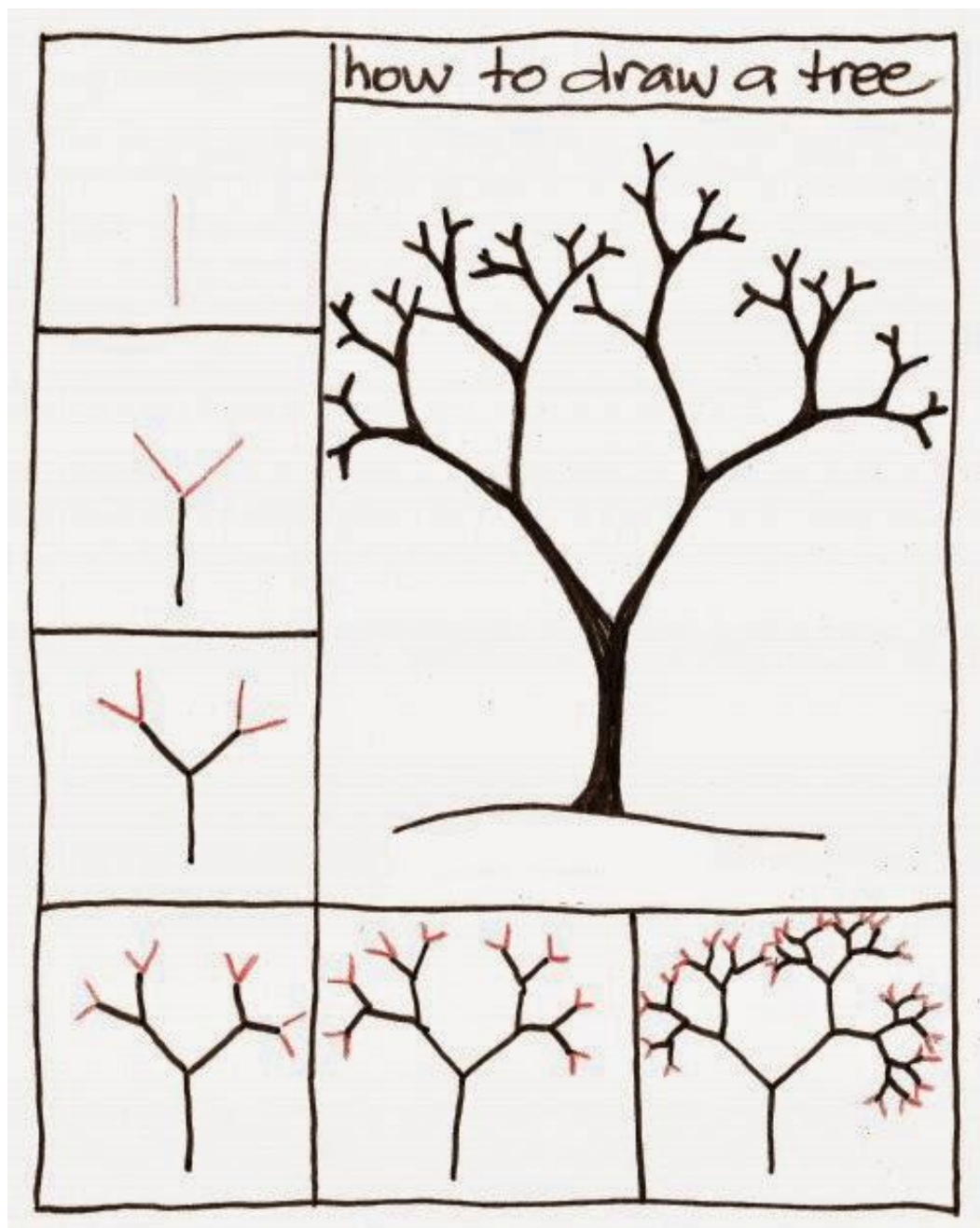
My Family Tree



Now turn this information into a gift for a member of your family or something to keep for yourself.

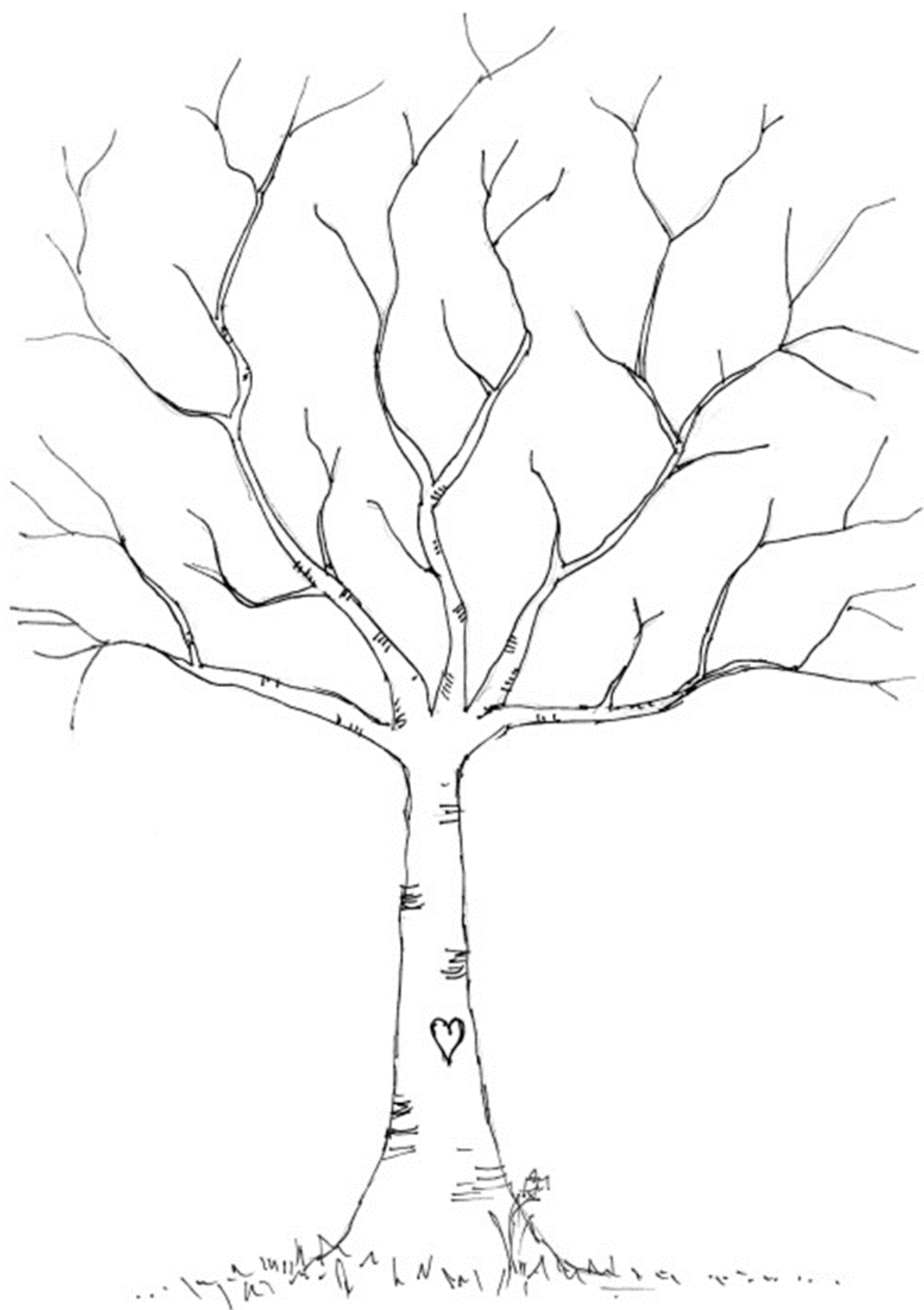
You will need;

- Paint

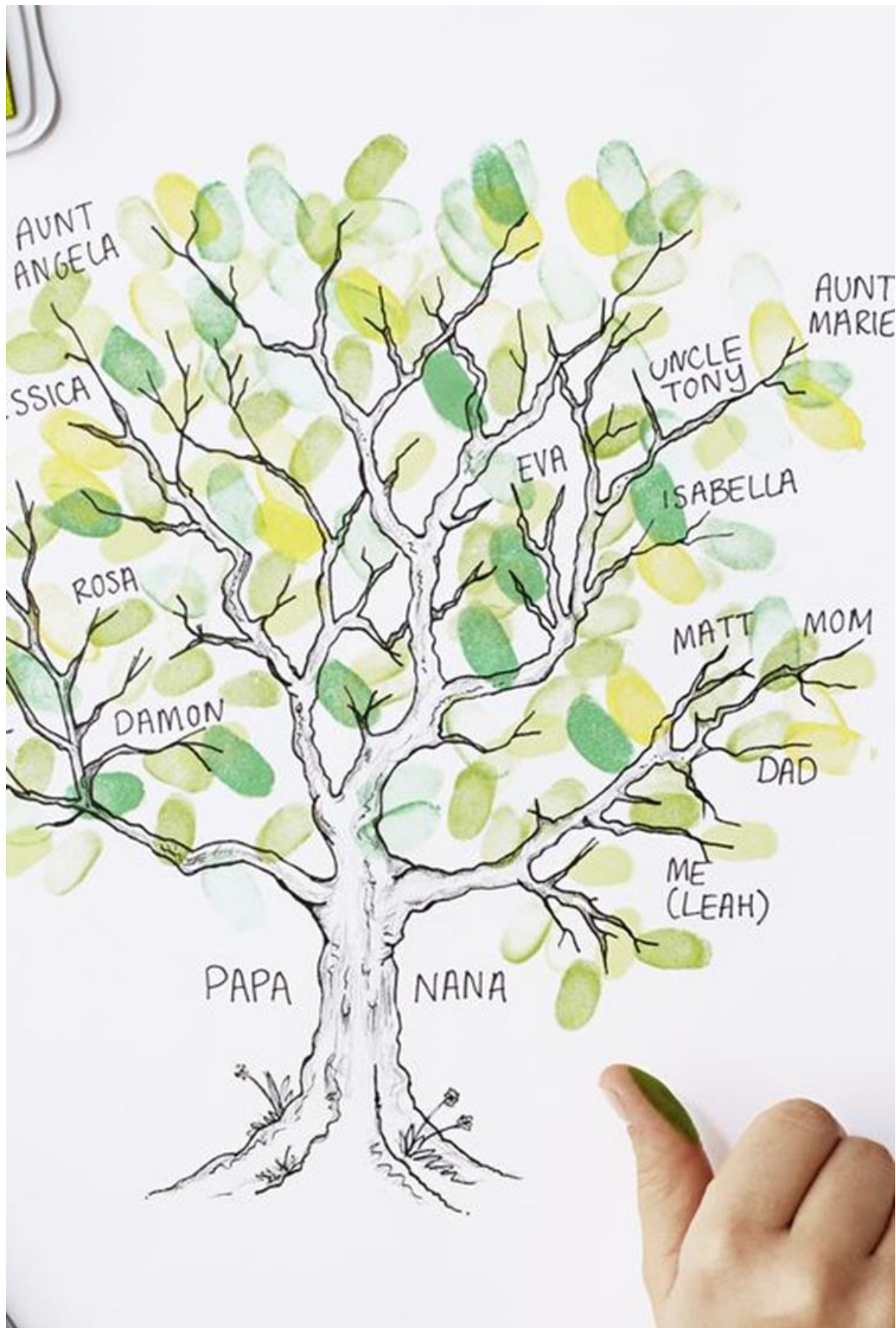


Sketch out your tree in pencil and when you are happy with your design, go over in pen. It can be as simple or as detailed as you like.
