Creative activity – Photography scavenger hunt

Emotion	Capture feelings experienced by people or a sense created by a scene (e.g., calm).
Bright Colours	Look for combinations of warm and cool, setting a mood or something that just catches your eye
A face in something	Look closely at the things around you, it's amazing how many faces you might see
Space	Play with negative or positive space to make a statement
Culture	What around you best represents Hartlepool to you? It could include social habits, beliefs, arts, music, language, or food
The inside of something	It could be a cup, a box, inside a tent?
An interesting sign	A road sign, a public notice or even your street name?
An object that looks like a letter	This seems a bit tricky at first but if you pay attention you'll find letters everywhere. Using the cropping tool on your phone will help.
Your favourite view	Just that, A familiar view that always makes you feel better.
Pattern	Identify a repeating or decorative design that catches the eye.
Something old	Look for something that's been weathered and battered and shows it's age, It could be a building or an object perhaps
A selfie	Don't worry, you don't necessarily have to show your face, but capture something of yourself for this last challenge



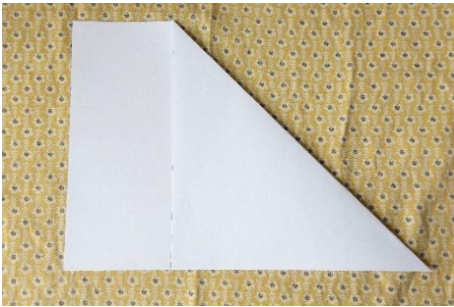

Craft activity – Love Heart Origami

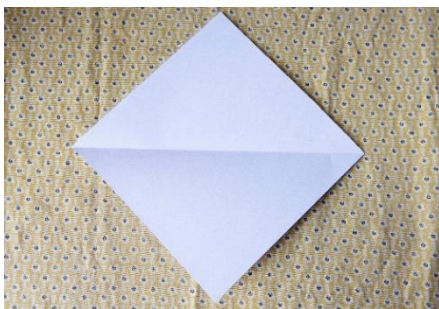


Materials:

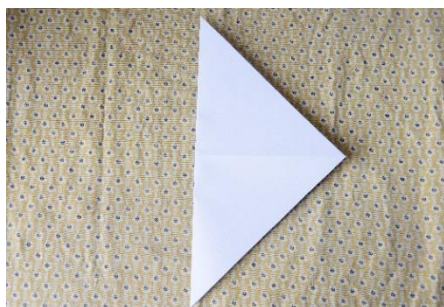
- White paper
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Pens



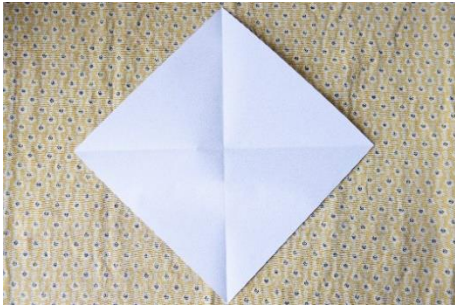
Step 1:
Fold the A4 paper as shown.



Step 2:
Cut the strip of paper so you end up with a square.
Turn it around so you have a diamond shape.

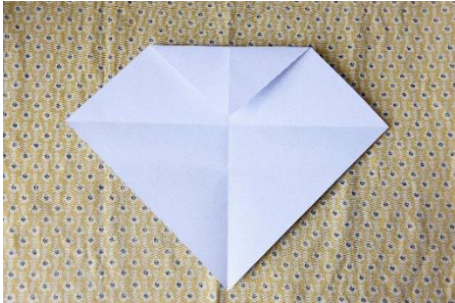


Step 3:
Fold the paper in half as shown.



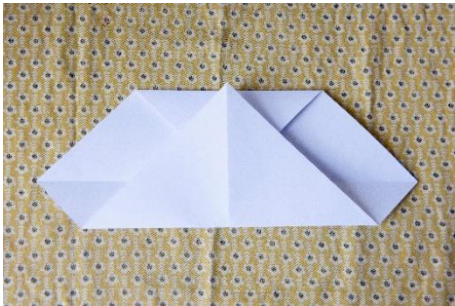
Step 4:

You should have a diamond shape like this with two folds.



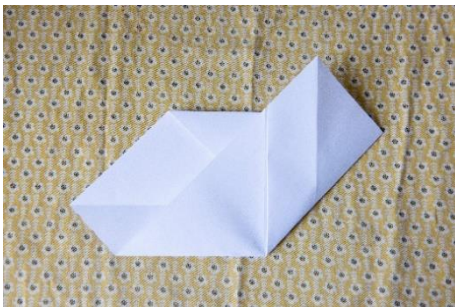
Step 5:

Fold the top corner to the centre.



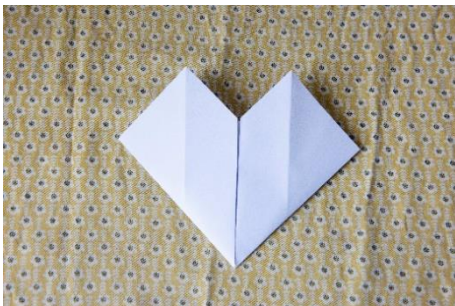
Step 6:

Fold the bottom corner to the top edge.



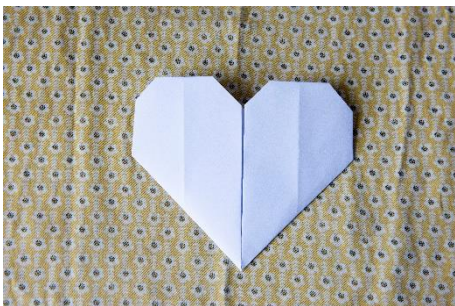
Step 7:

Fold the bottom right edge to the centre crease as shown and repeat for the left edge.



Step 8:

The love heart should now look like this.



Step 9:

Fold the top of the heart and the sides so the edges are flat. Decorate as you like.

Craft activity – Holi Celebration Art



Holi is a popular ancient Hindu festival, also known as the "festival of spring", the "festival of colours", and the "festival of love". The festival signifies the triumph of good over evil.

Materials:

- Watercolour Paint
- Paintbrush
- Wax Crayon
- Salt (optional)
- Cling film (optional)

Instructions:

1. Draw around your hand a few times with your wax crayons as above.
2. Create patterns on your hands with crayons
3. Colour different sections with watercolour paint
4. Make it as bright as you possibly can
5. You can experiment with salt and Clingfilm on the watercolour paint if you have any.

Craft activity – Woven heart

Please see your template on card in the pack



Instructions:

Each template has two sides which are mirror images of each other. Trace one of each heart and cut on the lines of the template.

Starting at the innermost line weave the strips of each heart in an “over under” pattern. If your kiddos are brand new to weaving check out this post on basic paper weaving skills.

Understanding the basics of weaving will save them lots of frustration and it only takes a few minutes!

Secure the edges with a dab of glue and let dry!
