Subject / Description & Reason for Decision:	A request has been received from the Bridlington Sailing Coble Society to receive the Viking and the Venus as a museum transfer. The vessels are currently on the water adjacent to the Wingfield Castle. These vessels are static displays and have taken on water. This has resulted in them sinking on numerous occasions in the past few years at a cost of £3,000 to refloat each time. It is felt that the vessels should be transferred to an organisation that can restore them and use them as sailing cobles.
