

## Online Applications

From 8<sup>th</sup> November 2021 you can apply for a primary school place online at [www.hartlepool.gov.uk/schooladmissions](http://www.hartlepool.gov.uk/schooladmissions) then click on the link for 'Apply For A Primary School Place'.

There are lots of benefits of applying online:

- You can apply 24 hours a day, 7 days a week
- There's no risk that your application will be lost in the post
- It's safe and secure, and quick and easy to use
- You can view your outcome on 19<sup>th</sup> April 2022 online, via the Parent Portal.

**Who makes the application?** The person who has parental responsibility should submit the application for the child's school place. If parents are separated, and both have parental responsibility, please ensure that you are both involved in the application process. If you need further advice about who should apply for your child's school place, please contact the Admissions Team on 01429 523765.

**Once I've made an application, and submitted it, can I change my preferences or submit other information?** You can make changes to your application right up to the closing date (**but not after the closing date**). Every time you make a change to your online application you will receive an e-mail confirming the status of your application. You can also check the status of your application when you log in to the system and select your existing records. Always make sure you re-submit each time you re-visit your application.

**What if I move address?** Whilst your child is in nursery, please let the School Admissions Team know of any address changes so we can ensure important documentation is sent to the correct address and your child is considered for your preferred schools under the correct criteria. If you change your address at any point, you must inform the Admissions Team in writing. It is not sufficient to amend your address on your online application. If you fail to notify us, this may result in the school place offered being withdraw.

**What if I can't apply online?** Please contact the Admissions Team (contact details below) to obtain a paper copy of the application form. Please do not apply online AND complete the paper application form. The closing date for applications is **15th January 2022**. Please note, the latest application submitted will be used for processing.

## A quick guide to the application process

In September 2022 your child will be due to start Primary School. This leaflet contains a basic guide to the application process and some information about the allocation of school places. A full version of the booklet 'Education in Hartlepool – September 2022', which gives details of all the schools maintained by this authority and the admission policies in place for 2022/23, is available on the Hartlepool Borough Council website at [www.hartlepool.gov.uk/schooladmissions](http://www.hartlepool.gov.uk/schooladmissions). A copy can also be obtained by calling the Admissions Team on 01429 523765. The booklet also contains guidance if you are considering **deferring/delaying the entry** of your child/ren into primary school. Please contact the Admissions Team (01429 523765) if you are considering **deferring/delaying entry**.

The timetable for the application process is as follows:

15 <sup>th</sup> January 2022	Closing date for receipt of applications (online/paper)
7 <sup>th</sup> March 2022	If you move house, this is the latest date for you to notify the admissions team of your new address for it to be considered in the primary allocation process.
19 <sup>th</sup> April 2022 (next working day following 16 <sup>th</sup> April 2022)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>For online applications - primary school offers available to view on website. If unsuccessful at gaining a place at a preferred school, a letter will be posted by 2nd class post</li> <li>For paper applications - allocation letters will be posted by 2nd class post</li> </ul>
3 <sup>rd</sup> May 2022	Closing date for places to be accepted
From 5 <sup>th</sup> May 2022	Admissions authorities to re-allocate any places that may have become vacant since the 19 <sup>th</sup> April offer date
17 <sup>th</sup> May 2022	Closing date for parents to lodge an appeal
June/July 2022	Appeals to be heard by Independent Panels

Please remember that it is important that you apply for a school place for your child. Applying online is quick, easy and you can view which school you have been allocated online. Go to [www.hartlepool.gov.uk/schooladmissions](http://www.hartlepool.gov.uk/schooladmissions) to begin the online application process. Please ensure your application is submitted by the closing date (above) as late applications are not considered until **after** all on-time applications.

## Admissions Criteria

Sometimes there are more applications for schools than there are places available. If this is the case, then places are offered up to the school's admission limit using the admissions criteria for the school. Please read the admissions criteria of the schools you are applying for carefully to ensure to know which criteria your application falls into and to check whether supporting documentation is required. Please provide any such documentation by the closing date.

The criteria for Hartlepool schools can be found in the 'Education in Hartlepool – September 2022' booklet which is available on our website. **Attendance at nursery is not a criterion at the majority of Hartlepool primary school and does not guarantee a place in the school.**
