Officer Making Decision: Managing Director.

Subject / Description & Reason for Decision:

Due to the high level of Omicron Covid cases across the Borough, the levels of staff who are isolating and concerns from Elected Members and staff about meeting face to face meetings, the Managing Director recommended that unless a report that is scheduled to go to a January Committee is time limited and urgent, it should be deferred to the February meeting of the Committee. Therefore, the Chair of Council and Leader of the Council were consulted and it was agreed with the Managing Director that the meeting of Full Council scheduled for 27 January 2022 be cancelled.
