

PRIVACY NOTICE - JOBS AND SKILLS SERVICE

The following information provides details on how we may collect, use and where appropriate share personal information for the administration and management of the towns allotments in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR). It should be read in conjunction with the Council's privacy notice document.

Why we collect your information	The Education & Skills Funding Agency (ESFA) are a part of the Department for Education (DfE) is responsible for funding education, employment and skills provision for children, young people and adults in England. It is also responsible for delivery of key services in the education, employment and skills sector in England including the apprenticeship service, the provision of information, advice and guidance through the National Careers Service, and the Learning Records Service. They may use your personal information in delivery of this work.	
	Hartlepool Borough Council's Jobs & Skills Service are a provider for the delivery of education, employment and skills provision. For the purposes of relevant data protection legislation, the DfE is the data controller for personal information and the data processor is both DfE and providers such as the Council.	
What information do you	The types of data that will be processed include:	
collect about me?	 Personal Details such as Name, Address, Telephone Number and Date of Birth; Family, Lifestyle and Social Circumstances; Employment and Educational Attainment, and; Education and Training Details. 	
Will you collect more sensitive personal information about me?	 The Service may also collect and process information categorised as sensitive in connection with the delivery of education, employment and skills provision. This may include: Physical or Mental Health Details 	
How will you collect personal information about me?	 We collect personal information directly by you through various means including: Face to Face Over the Telephone Via Websites In Emails 	
	ESFA may also collect personal information about you from other systems or organisations funded by ESFA and from organisations that introduce you to us; so that we can make contact with you.	
How will the Council use the information it collects about me?	We collect your personal information where the law allows it, or we have a legal obligation to do so. Your personal information is collected to enable us to carry out the functions of the DfE.

use my personal data?	For personal information, the condition that applies to processing done by ESFA is that it is necessary for "a function of a government department"	Legal: Article 6(1)(e) of the GDPR	
	For sensitive personal information, such as information about health, processing by ESFA meets the condition that it is "necessary for the purposes of … employment, social security and social protection".	Legal : Article 9(2)(b) of the GDPR	
What if I don't want to provide the Council with my personal information?	If you do not provide the information as described above you will be unable to participate on the education, employment and skills provision delivered by the Council.		
Will you share my personal information with third parties?	ESFA may share your personal information with other services run by the ESFA, other parts of the DfE, and partner organisations such as the Council, where the law allows it or we have a legal obligation to do so:		
	 With a third party who is working for ESFA under contract With other organisations such as Jobcentre Plus for the purposes of Administration 		
	 Provision of career and other guidance Statistical and research purposes, relating to education, training, employment and well-being prevention or detection of crime. 		
	This sharing includes the ESFA Datacube which provides research and statistical monitoring information which is available to the Council via ESFA.
