Decision:

Purchase of land at Hartlepool Marina in connection with the replacement of the Damboard - graving dock, dock mouth.

A project is currently being progressed to replace the Damboard structure which maintains water levels in the graving dock at National Museum of the Royal Navy Hartlepool, in which HMS Trincomalee is moored. The replacement is necessary due to the deterioration of the condition of the Damboard and the need to dry-dock PS Wingfield Castle to carry out extensive repairs.

Following an option study and the completion of both a 3D scan of the dock and an intensive dive survey it has been decided to utilise a stoplog solution rather than a like for like replacement of the Damboard or other alternatives. This is for reasons of capital and operating expense and ease of use and maintenance, the stoplog solution having scored well on all these points.

However, the stoplogs, together with a new underwater concrete aprons need to be installed at a point in the dock mouth further out than the existing Damboard, in the part of the dock mouth currently owned by Hartlepool Marina Ltd. The Council therefore needs to acquire the necessary land from the Marina

Terms have been agreed as set out in the **CONFIDENTIAL ANNEX.**
