

# NOTICE OF ELECTION

## Combined Authority Mayoral Election

### For the Tees Valley Combined Authority

1. An election is to be held for a combined authority mayor of the Tees Valley Combined Authority.
2. Nomination papers can be obtained from the office of the Combined Area Returning Officer, Room 65, Municipal Buildings, Church Road, Stockton on Tees TS19 1UE, during the times stated below.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Combined Area Returning Officer at Room 65, Municipal Buildings, Church Road, Stockton on Tees TS19 1UE between 10am and 4pm on any working day after publication of this notice but no later than **4pm on Friday 5 April 2024**.
4. A deposit of £5,000 must be paid for each candidate by the deadline for delivery of nominations either by (a) legal tender or (b) by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom or (c) by an electronic transfer (BACS) through your online banking facility direct to Stockton-on-Tees Borough Council using sort code 55-61-00 Account number 07436998 and quoting your name.
5. If the election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday 2 May 2024**.
6. Applications to register to vote must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by **12 midnight on Tuesday 16 April 2024**. Applications can be made online: [www.gov.uk/register-to-vote](http://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote).
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 17 April 2024**.
8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024**. 9. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Wednesday 24 April 2024**.

10. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the relevant Electoral Registration Officer by **5pm on Thursday 2 May 2024**.
