Hartlepool County Constituency UKPGE – 4 July 2024 Voter ID Data

Data released today for the Hartlepool County constituency shows the number of people who brought ID to the polling station for the UK Parliamentary General election.

The data shows that 99.9% of electors voting in Hartlepool County constituency polling stations brought photo ID that met voter ID requirements.

Collated figures across the area show 25019 electors voted at our 57 polling stations in the general election.

At the end of polling day, 29 electors who tried to vote in a polling station were not given a ballot paper because they did not meet the voter ID requirements -0.1%.

The figures also show while 119 electors were initially turned away, 90 returned with acceptable ID and were able to vote. This means 75.6 % of those initially turned away returned and were issued with a ballot paper.
