#### DBS DOCUMENT CHECK LIST - UK ROUTE 1

To apply through Route 1 the applicant must produce 3 documents:

- o 1 document from Group 1 and
- 2 further documents from Group 1, 2a or 2b; one of which must verify their current address

# You must provide documents to show proof of all names you have formerly or are currently known by

## **GROUP 1 – (Primary Trusted - Identity Documents)**

#### **Any Current valid Passport**

**Current Driving Licence** UK/Isle of Man/Channel Islands. From 8 June 2015, the paper counterpart to the photocard driving licence will not be valid and will no longer be issued by DVLA

**Birth Certificate** UK,/Isle of Man/Channel Islands issued within 12 months of birth - including those issued by UK authorities overseas, for example embassies, High Commissions and HM Forces

Adoption Certificate (UK and Channel Islands)

**Biometric Residence Permit (UK)** 

#### GROUP 2a - (Trusted Government /State Issued Documents)

**Current driving licence photocard** - (full or provisional) - All countries outside the UK (excluding Isle of Man and Channel Islands)

Current driving licence (full or provisional) - paper version (if issued before 1998) - UK, Isle of Man, and Channel Islands

Certified copy of Birth Certificate (UK, Isle of Man and Channel Islands) - issued after time of birth

Marriage/Civil Partnership Certificate (UK and Channel Islands)

**Immigration document, visa, or work permit** - Issued by a country outside the UK. Valid only for roles whereby the applicant is living and working outside of the UK. Visa/permit must relate to the non-UK country in which the role is based

**HM Forces ID Card (UK)** 

Fire Arms Licence (UK, Isle of Man and Channel Islands)

### **GROUP 2b** - (Financial /Social History Documents)

Mortgage Statement (UK) – issued in the last 12 months

Bank/Building Society Statement (UK and Channel Islands) - it should be less than three months old

**Bank or building society statement** (Countries outside of the UK) - Issued in last 3 months - branch must be in the country where the applicant lives and works

Bank/Building Society Account Opening Confirmation Letter (UK) - it should be less than three months old

Credit Card Statement (UK) - it should be less than three months old

Financial Statement - e.g. pension, endowment (UK) - it should be issued within the past 12 months

P45/P60 Statement (UK & Channel Islands) - it should be issued within the past 12 months

Council Tax Statement (UK & Channel Islands) - it should be issued within the past 12 months

**Letter of sponsorship from future employment provider** - Non-UK only - valid only for applicants residing outside of the UK at time of application – must still be valid

Utility Bill (UK) - Not Mobile Telephone - it should be less than three months old

Benefit Statement (UK) - e.g. Child Allowance, Pension - it should be less than three months old

Central or local government, government agency, or local council document giving entitlement, for example from the Department for Work and Pensions, the Employment Service, HMRC (UK & Channel Islands) - it should be less than three months old

EEA National ID Card - Must still be valid

Irish Passport Card - Cannot be used with an Irish passport. Must still be valid

Cards carrying the PASS accreditation logo (UK, Isle of Man & Channel Islands) - Must still be valid

**Letter confirming their identity from Head Teacher or College Principal**— (16/19 year olds in full time education only) — **EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES ONLY**
