

Hartlepool Borough Council Admission Appeals Timetable 2024/2025

In accordance with the School Admission Appeals Code, the Council as the admission authority for community schools must set a timetable for organising and hearing education appeals. The following timetable will apply to appeals for admission to community and voluntary controlled schools lodged within the 2024/245 academic year, this includes:

- Appeals for entry into Reception Class – September 2025 Intake
- Appeals for entry into Year 7 – September 2025 Intake
- In-Year appeals received during 2024/25 academic year

Voluntary aided, foundation and academies within the Borough of Hartlepool will also follow the dates below.

Appeals will be heard between	7 th May 2025 and 15 th June 2025	12 th June 2025 and 17 th July 2025

Appeals in respect of late applications will generally be heard within 40 school days from the deadline for lodging appeals where possible, or within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged. Appeals in respect of in-year applications will be heard within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged.

Appellants (the person(s) lodging an appeal) will receive a letter notifying them of the date, time and venue of the appeals panel appointed to hear their appeal at least 10 school days before the hearing.

Appellants and the admission authority must provide the clerk to the appeals panel with any documents they wish to submit to the panel no later than 6 working days before the appeals hearing.

The clerk to the panel will send to the panel, the appellants and the admission authority all the documentary evidence to be considered at the hearing at least 5 working days before the hearing.

The clerk to the panel will send a letter to the appellants and the admission authority notifying them of the Panel's decision and the reasons for the decision within 5 working days of the hearing wherever possible.
