Subject: APPLICATION FOR A NEW PREMISES LICENCE -ASHFIELD CARAVAN PARK

### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To consider an application for a new Premises Licence in respect of Ashfield Caravan Park, Dalton Piercy, Hartlepool.

## 2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Applicant: Ashfield Caravan Park Limited
  - Premises: Ashfield Caravan Park Ashfield Farm Dalton Piercy Hartlepool TS27 3HY

## 3. SUMMARY OF THE APPLICATION

3.1 The applicant has applied for the following:

Sale of Alcohol	Monday – Saturday Sunday	1100 – 2300 1100 – 2200
Live Music	Monday – Sunday	1300 – 2100
Recorded Music	Monday – Sunday	1300 – 2100

All of the above activities are restricted to between the months of March to October inclusive.

A copy of the application and photographs of the site are attached as **Appendices 1 & 2**.

3.2 The application has been advertised in the prescribed manner and one relevant representation has been received from an Interested Party who resides in the vicinity of the premises (Appendix 3).

- 3.3 The nature of the representation received can be summarised as follows:
  - The potential for crime and disorder caused by the provision of alcohol and live music
  - Public nuisance caused by noise pollution
  - Public safety concerns specifically caused by the 'inadequate infrastructure' surrounding the site
- 3.4 Following receipt of the above representation, and in compliance with statutory requirements, a Notice of Hearing has been sent to both the applicant and interested party.

## 4. **ISSUES**

- 4.1 The application for a premises licence was originally received on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2007 and related to the sale of alcohol and the provision of musical entertainment across the entire caravan site.
- 4.2 As appropriate planning permission was not in place at that time, the licence application was adjourned by Members at a Licensing Sub-Committee hearing on 6<sup>th</sup> July 2007, pending the outcome of the planning permission application.
- 4.3 Planning permission was finally granted by the Planning Inspectorate in December 2007 and, as a result, the licence application process has recommenced.
- 4.4 The Planning Inspectorate has imposed a number of conditions relating to the use of the site and, as a result, the applicant has amended their application to ensure the licence does not contradict the planning restrictions.
- 4.5 Following the original application in April 2007 a number of objections were received from both Interested Parties and Responsible Authorities, however all but one of these have been withdrawn as a result of the application being amended.
- 4.6 Having regard to the representation received, Members may take any of the following steps for the promotion of the licensing objectives:
  - i) Grant the application without amendment
  - ii) Grant the application with conditions, or amended conditions
  - iii) Refuse the application
- 4.7 The licensing objectives are:
  - i) The prevention of crime and disorder
  - ii) Public safety

- iii) The prevention of public nuisance, and
- iv) The protection of children from harm
- 4.8 Members are reminded that they must only consider those aspects of the licence application that are relevant to the representations received.

# 5. RECOMMENDATIONS

5.1 That Members consider the representations made by the applicant and Interested Party and determine what aspects, if any, of the proposed application should be granted and, if appropriate, what conditions, if any, should be attached. 1.1



Dear Mr Harrison.

History:

#### Caravan site, Dalton Plercy.

Thank you for the information in respect of this. I hope that I can now make an effective representation in respect of the proposed licensing of the above development. It is perhaps convenient if I address the headings as you helpfully listed them in your previous e-mail.

#### Prevention of Crime and Disorder

The site is currently a field. Any development, therefore, is going to create risks that were not there before. Caravanning is an esoteric activity not associated with crime and disorder, but consumption of alcohol is. The provision of alcohol can only serve to attract people other than caravanners, alongside the provision of live music which can serve no other purpose than to attract crowds other than caravanners. I suspect that the live music proposed is not likely to be a string quartet. Where crowds of people are attracted by the provision of alcohol and loud music crime, and the potential for disorder, is inevitable.

I understand that the caravan site is proposed for eight months of the year whereas the licence is sought for 12 months of the year from 12 noon to midnight. This illustrates that the caravan site is very much a secondary activity, an entree to the granting of a licence which is the proposed real use of the site.

The sorts of crimes associated with licensed premises are assaults and thefts, and disorderly conduct under the Public Order Act. In addition, for a site such as this, there is increased potential for drink driving. For Hartlepool this is as ' middle of the country' as it gets, and can only be accessed by motor vehicle.

#### Prevention of Public Nuisance.

Insofar as crime and disorder are public nuisances I repeat the comments made above. However, an additional consequence will be that access to and from the village of Dalton Piercy will be made more difficult and potentially hazardous by the large number of people and vehicles that the owner hopes to attract to his development.

The question of noise pollution at unsocial hours is also an issue, particularly if loud music is to be played out of doors. We regularly hear events at Summerhill in the summer months, particularly if there is a public address system. The proposed development is threequarters of a mile from the centre of Daiton, whereas Summerhill is two or three miles away. Living in a rural area one would expect and welcome the occasional horse show or agricultural event, but live music - amplified and in the proposed development is the played of the playe the open - would be a public nuisance. Local residents and walkers, horse riders and other users of the countryside are entitled not to have their experience spoilt with the intrusion of amplified music. They access the countryside, as do many caravanners, to get away from such things. It is a nuisance to the general public of Hartlepool not to be able to find rural peace and quiet within the boundaries of the Borough.

Public Safety

You state that issues such as road safety away from the premises, and outside of the licence holders control, are not a licensing matter. I disagree. I accept that once a licence is granted road safety away from the premises is outside of the control of the licence holder, but we are dealing here with whether a licence is granted in the first place, which is your decision. The attraction of large numbers of people and vehicles to the site directly as a consequence of the granting of a licence, considering the inadequate infrastructure surrounding the site, has significant public safety issues. There will inevitably be bodily harm and death directly as a result of large numbers of people and vehicles being attracted by licensed premises. This is already an issue with the roads as they are,

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#### Protection of Children from Harm

I have nothing of significance to add under this heading, although it will of course be a natural consequence that more children will be brought to and from the site by car should a licence be allowed.

I hope these representations will be considered by the Licensing Committee, and would welcome the opportunity of addressing them personally.
