3. BACKGROUND

3.1 The premises to which this application relates currently benefits from a Premises Licence for the ground floor only that was granted by Licensing Sub-Committee in January 2006. As the applicant wishes for the licence to be extended so as to incorporate the first floor, the Licensing Act requires that a new licence application be made for the entire building and not a variation to the existing licence.

- 3.2 The application has been advertised in the prescribed manner and two representations have been received. One from Environmental Health (Health and Safety) and one from Cleveland Police (see Appendices II III).
- 3.3 The nature of the representations received can be summarised as follows:
 - Environmental Health has indicated that they believe conditions should be applied to the licence in order to promote the public safety licensing objective.
 - Cleveland Police have stated that the area already suffers from crime and disorder and drink related problems and are of the opinion that a number of the licensing objectives would be undermined if the licence was granted.
- 3.4 Following receipt of the above representations, and in compliance with statutory requirements, a Notice of Hearing has been sent to the applicant and those making representations.

4. **ISSUES**

- 4.1 As relevant representations have been received within the prescribed time period, a hearing must be held for Members to consider those representations (unless all parties agree a hearing is unnecessary).
- 4.2 Members are advised that the applicant's premises are situated within Hartlepool's 'Special Policy' area.
- 4.3 The Special Policy forms part of Hartlepool's Licensing Policy and states that, because of the significant number of licensed premises in the specified area, there is a potential impact on the promotion of the four licensing objectives.
- 4.4 The existence of a Special Policy creates a rebuttable presumption that applications for new premises licences will normally be refused, unless the applicant can demonstrate that there will be no negative cumulative impact on one or more of the licensing objectives.
- 4.5 Having regard to the representations received, Members may take any of the following steps for the promotion of the licensing objectives:
 - i) Grant the application without amendment
 - ii) Grant the application in part and/or with conditions or amended conditions

iii) Refuse the application

- 4.6 The licensing objectives are:
 - i) The prevention of crime and disorder
 - ii) Public safety
 - iii) The prevention of public nuisance, and
 - iv) The protection of children from harm
- 4.7 Members are reminded that they must only consider those aspects of the licence application that are relevant to the representations received.
- 4.8 Members are also reminded that this is a new application for a premises that already holds a licence for the ground floor. This licence will remain in force until surrendered by the licence holder and any decision about the application being considered today will not affect, in any way, the licence already issued.

5. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

5.1 That members consider the representations made by the applicant and responsible authorities and determine what aspects, if any, of the proposed application should be granted and, if appropriate, what conditions, if any, should be attached.

Licensing Act 2003 Re: Application for a Premises Licence 2 Victoria Road, Hartlepool

I am in receipt of a completed copy of your application for a licence under the Licensing Act 2003 and as a designated 'Responsible Authority' I have considered the contents carefully in relation to the Public Safety Licensing Objective.

I am of the view that your completed Operating Schedule fails to (adequately) address the following matters. I am therefore considering making a recommendation to the Licensing Authority recommending that your licence should only be granted subject to the inclusion of the following conditions.

- Except with the prior written approval of the Licensing Authority and subject to any conditions which may be attached to such approval: -
 - (a) No special effects, naked flames, smoke production or any process creating a risk of fire, or the illusion of smoke or fire shall be used for the purpose of providing regulated entertainment on the premises.
 - (b) No explosives or highly flammable substances shall be brought into or used on the premises.
 - (c) No special effects shall be used or displays given on the premises, which consist of or include the use of lasers.

Applications for consent, giving detailed descriptions of the equipment to be used and details of the event, including dates and times must be made not less than 28 days before the date of the event.

 The licensee shall ensure that the electrical socket outlets in the licensed premises to be used with electrical equipment provided for the purpose of entertainment shall be protected by a residual current device being a 30 mA tripping circuit.

- 3. In the event of the fire alarm being activated a suitable relay should be provided so that the electrical power supply to all sound amplification system in the licensed premises shall be immediately intercepted so that the alarm can be clearly heard in all parts of the licensed premises.
- There shall be maintained on the premises at all times an adequate and appropriate supply of first aid equipment and materials for use by patrons.
- A drugs policy should be prepared and implemented. In preparing the policy regard should be had to the guidance document 'safer clubbing' - Guidance for licensing authorities, club managers and promoters, published by the Home Office and London Drugs Policy Forum in partnership with Release. (Copies of this document are available from <u>www.drugs.gov.uk.</u>)

If you are willing for the above conditions to be attached to your Operating Schedule I would ask that you sign the enclosed acceptance form and return it to the above address, marked for my attention, by **2 April 2008**. This will negate the need for me to make a representation in respect of your application.

If you are unwilling to accept the above conditions, it is likely that the matter will need to be resolved by the Council's Licensing Committee, by way of a hearing.

Cleveland Police are aware that although there is an existing premises licence in respect of 2 Victoria Road on the ground level, the extent of the variation of the licence to incorporate the top floor has resulted in the requirement for an application for a new premises licence.

The premise is situated close to a residential area and in an area which already suffers from crime and disorder and drink related problems. Cleveland Police are therefore of the opinion that if granted, the crime and disorder, public safety and public nuisance objectives may be undermined and the premises may add to the problems already encountered within the vicinity.

The premise is situated in an area of Hartlepool which has been declared as saturated and therefore, a special policy area. It is therefore the opinion of Cleveland Police that the onus is on the applicant to demonstrate how the application, if granted, will not have a negative impact on the licensing objectives.
