1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To consider an application for a premises licence in respect of 40 Wharton Terrace, Hartlepool.

2. BACKGROUND

- 2.1 Applicant: Mrs Pamela Mann
Premises: 57 Allerton Close
Hartlepool

3. SUMMARY OF THE APPLICATION

- 3.1 The applicant has applied for a new premises licence to authorise the following activities: -

Supply of Alcohol (for consumption off trade premises)	Mon – Sat	0600 – 2100
	Sun	0700 – 2100

A copy of the application is attached as **Appendix 1**.

- 3.2 The application has been advertised in the prescribed manner and seven representations have been received from Interested Parties who reside in the immediate vicinity (**Appendices 2 - 8**).
- 3.3 The representations refer to crime, disorder and anti social behaviour in the area.

4. ISSUES

- 4.1 As relevant representations have been received within the prescribed time period, a hearing must be held for Members to consider those representations (unless all parties agree a hearing is unnecessary).
- 4.2 The applicant has, as part of their application, agreed to a number of conditions that will be attached to the premises licence should it be granted. These conditions include: -

- A CCTV system, of a standard approved by Cleveland Police, shall be installed at the premises. Video recordings shall be made immediately available to the Police or licensing officers on request.
- A 'Challenge 21' scheme shall be adopted, requiring anyone who appears to be under the age of 21 to produce proof of age before they are supplied with alcohol.

4.3 Having regard to the representations received, Members may take any of the following steps for the promotion of the licensing objectives:

- i) Grant the application without amendment
- ii) Grant the application with conditions, or amended conditions
- iii) Reject those parts of the application that are relevant to the representations received

4.4 The licensing objectives are:

- i) The prevention of crime and disorder
- ii) Public safety
- iii) The prevention of public nuisance, and
- iv) The protection of children from harm

5. RECOMMENDATIONS

5.1 That Members consider the representations made by the applicant and Interested Parties and determine what aspects, if any, of the application should be granted and, if appropriate, what conditions, if any, should be attached.

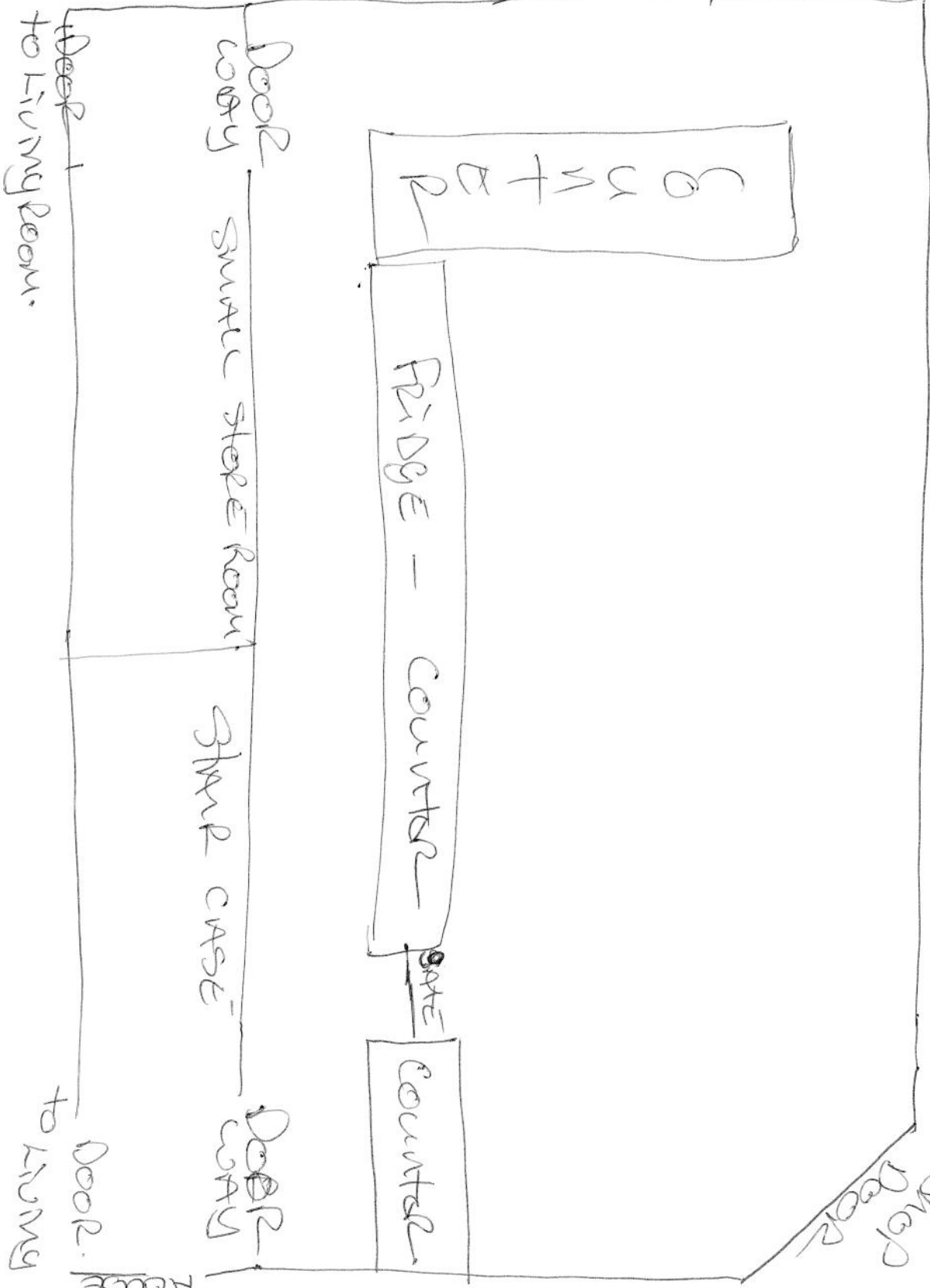

Dear Sir/Madam

I wish to object to the application for an alcohol licence for 40 Wharton Terrace, on the corner of Mapleton Road. At the moment we have an alcohol and binge drinking problem, so giving another licence would just be like adding wood to a fire.

Within roughly 400 yards along Raby Road there are a Pub, a Working Mans Club and three General Dealers selling alcohol. Travel 400 yards in the other direction and there are three more General Dealers in Chatham Road selling alcohol. Supermarkets keep getting the blame for our alcohol problems but the fact that you can buy it at any corner shop at any time of the day is the main problem.

Not many years ago this area of terraced houses around the proposed shop were classed as a nice area, people owned their own homes and looked after them. Now the area has been taken over by landlords. Virtually all of Mapleton Road and St Oswald Street are owned by landlords with other streets also being infiltrated. What comes with landlords as our Local MP said last week is their careless attitude in placing unsuitable tenants in some of their properties.

I notice from the application that the shop wishes to open at 6 a.m. six days a week and 7 a.m. on Sunday. This is supposed to be a General Dealers which will not sell newspapers, why so early?

Finally the shop is only 100 yards from Dyke House School which has over 1000 pupils, most of which travel in that direction at lunchtime and at the end of their school day. I am sure that quite a few of the pupils will gather around at these times annoying the few decent people left, dropping their rubbish and sitting on the "lovely" flower beds.

It would probably help with making your decision if you had a walk around the area yourselves.

The shop has been there for many years (I have grown up in that street and have also worked there whilst I was younger) and it has been successful to all its previous owners without the need to sell alcohol. What will happen if the shop can not be run without the need to sell alcohol?? With the 24hr shop and Asda nearby, surely it would be more profitable to sell to children under the age of 18 if the shop was not taking enough money to cover all overheads?? This might start as the odd sale, but one buy would lead to others following suit. The shop surely must not rely on alcohol sales to survive.

The shop is situated on the corner of Mapleton Rd and Wharton Tce. It is away from the main road and the area is not at all well -light. Groups of youths congregate either on the corner, outside the back alley and at the back of the Enterprise centre. At weekends they think its extremely clever to smash bottles, throw litter, scream and shout till all hours after buying alcopops/cans from wherever will sell them to them.

If a licence were obtained, the shop would become a main feature for youths even more so than now. I also think, as it is hard to determine, especially a girls age, even younger children would be encouraged to try and either buy it for themselves or ask someone else of under-age. Even adults tend to buy it for the under age, as this seems the modern way of today

I, myself, have 2 children of school age, and am extremely concerned about letting them go around the corner to their nana's where drunken youths choose to cause a nuisance to the other residents whilst loitering - sober or drunk - on the street corner

I wish to register my objection to the granting of a Liquor License for the premises of number 40 Wharton Terrace, Hartlepool.

Having lived in the area for close to forty years I see no reason to grant such a license, we are well enough catered for when it comes to buying alcohol within this area of Hartlepool, there are already two outlets on Raby Road opposite the Rovers Social Club, along with the all night shop a little further along which causes no end of trouble and law breaking of one kind or another, I do not want to see this kind of behaviour on my door step.

I believe the applicant has not fully evaluated the potential of the returns on such a venture with this shop, we are not a commercial area but a residential area, having a license off door would to my mind attract the more undesirable types into Wharton Terrace and our homes and property would be put at risk.

It also goes without saying that were drink is trouble will be close behind along with law breaking, the applicant has given little if any at all thought for us living with in the Wharton Terrace, the shop is going to be a hot spot for public disorder, that is the usual nature of such outlets.

The protection of children from harm with such a shop is also a consideration that I must point out, with the sale of alcohol to under age youngsters a real problem in this day and age, another outlet for children to get hold of cheap drink should not be made available.

I would hope that the committee take my objection to the application for a license into consideration, I, along with other residents in Wharton Terrace do not wish to see any licensed shop opening up next door to our homes, I can see no benefit to us and the surrounding streets for such a shop.
