CONVERSION AND VARIATION FOR BELLE VUE COMMUNITY SPORTS AND YOUTH CENTRE

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To consider an application for the conversion of an existing Public Entertainment Licence into a Premises Licence and the subsequent variation of such in respect of Belle Vue Community Sports and Youth Centre, Hartlepool.

2. BACKGROUND

2.1 Applicant: Belle Vue Community Sports and Youth Centre Premises: Belle Vue Community Sports and Youth Centre

Kendal Road Hartlepool TS25 1QU

- 2.2 The applicant currently holds a Public Entertainment Licence authorising the following activities: -
 - Music, Singing and Dancing (up to an occupancy capacity of 150)
- 2.3 The current licences permit the above activities as follows: -

Monday – Saturday 1200 – 2400 Sunday (Public Music Only) 2000 – 2230

3. SUMMARY OF APPLICATION

3.1 The applicant has applied to convert the above activities into a new Premises Licence and thereafter to vary the new licence to add the following activities: -

1.	Indoor Sporting Events	Sun – Fri	0900 - 2200
		Saturday	0900 - 2300
2.	Boxing and Wrestling	Saturday	0900 - 2300
		Sunday	0900 - 2200

- 3.2 The proposed closing time for the premises is 2200 between Sunday and Friday and 2300 on Saturdays.
- 3.3 A copy of the application is attached as Appendix I.
- 3.4 The application has been advertised in the prescribed manner and one relevant representation has been received from an **interested party** who resides in the vicinity of the premises (Appendix II).
- 3.5 The representation states that there are concerns about noise, anti-social behaviour, public safety and increased crime. The objection also refers to correspondence concerning an application for a variation to the applicant's Public Entertainment Licence made in February 2005. The application was to increase the licensed occupancy figure from 150 to 950 and attracted objections from Hartlepool Council's Acting Traffic and Transportation Manager and Cleveland Police. The application for variation was subsequently withdrawn by the applicant.
- 3.6 Members are advised that the variation now being requested by the applicant does not include any request for an increase in the maximum occupancy levels relating to the provision of music, singing and dancing which will therefore remain at 150. There is, however, no occupancy limit relating to the proposed additional activities of indoor sporting events and boxing and wrestling.
- 3.7 If Members are minded to grant the application for variation, they may choose to impose a condition restricting occupancy levels for the additional activities if they believe to do so would be consistent with the representation received from the interested party.

4. ISSUES

- 4.1 As relevant representations have been received within the prescribed time period, a hearing must be held for Members to consider those representations (unless all parties agree a hearing is unnecessary).
- 4.2 The Public Protection & Housing Division has received no complaints relating to noise emanating from these premises, although a number of calls have been received regarding parking congestion in the area.
- 4.3 Having regard to the representations received, Members may take any of the following steps for the promotion of the licensing objectives.
 - 1) Grant the application without amendment
 - 2) Grant the application with conditions, or amended conditions
 - 3) Reject those parts of the variation that are relevant to the representations received

- 4.4 The licensing objectives are:
 - a) the prevention of crime and disorder;
 - b) public safety;
 - c) the prevention of public nuisance; and
 - d) the protection of children from harm
- 4.5 Members are reminded that they must only consider those aspects of the licence variation that are relevant to the representations received.

5. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 5.1 That Members grant the conversion of the Justices' licence into a new Premises Licence.
- 5.2 That Members consider the representations made by the applicant and interested parties and determine what aspects, if any, of the proposed variation should be granted and, if appropriate, what conditions, if any, should be attached.

I would refer to the Belle Vue Centre's recent licence application in February 2005, for a variation to it's entertainment licence, which was subsequently withdrawn, and that of my letter of objection and of fellow residents, also letters of objection from Cleveland Police 9th March 2005 and Mike Blair acting Transport and Traffic Manager (H.B.C) of 1st March 2005, whom together with residents expressed their concerns as to the potential number of visitors/customers permitted to attend this centre, with all the associated traffic congestions, road safety issues and parking problems also with the prominent crime and anti-social behaviour problems that would occur with the centre's increased musical entertainment and sporting events.

In addition all the above activities would be instrumental in attracting the disruptive and disturbing element of our society, to this residential area.
