Subject: APPLICATION FOR A NEW PREMISES LICENCE

FOR MR CHEFFEE TAKE-AWAY RESTAURANT

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To consider an application for a new Premises Licence in respect of Mr Cheffee, 80 York Road, Hartlepool.

2. BACKGROUND

2.1 Applicant: David Coulson

Premises: Mr Cheffee

80 York Road Hartlepool

2.2 This application is for a new Premises Licence as the activities to which this application refers were not previously licensable and no other licences are currently in force.

3. SUMMARY OF APPLICATION

3.1 The applicant has applied for a new Premises Licence for the following activities: -

Late Night Refreshment Mon – Sun 1600 – 0300

- 3.2 A copy of the application is attached as Appendix I.
- 3.3 The application has been advertised in the prescribed manner and two representations have been received. One from **Environmental Health** (Appendix II) and from **Wharton & Errol Street Residents Association** (Appendix III).
- 3.4 The representation from Environmental Health states that due to the proximity of the premises to other residential properties the provision of late night refreshment should be limited to 1:30 a.m. and for the premises to be closed by 2:00 a.m.
- 3.5 Wharton & Errol Street Residents Association have highlighted their concerns about late night revellers causing a disturbance in and around the area including shouting, swearing, urinating, banging car doors, vomiting and vandalism to homes and vehicles.

4. ISSUES

- 4.1 As relevant representations have been received within the prescribed time period, a hearing must be held for Members to consider those representations (unless all parties agree a hearing is unnecessary).
- 4.2 Members are also advised that the applicant's premises are situated within Hartlepool's 'Special Policy' area.
- 4.3 In addition to the two representations received, Hartlepool Borough Council's Planning Department has indicated there is a planning condition for the premises that it shall only operate until 0230 on weekdays and Saturdays and midnight on Sundays.
- 4.4 Hartlepool Borough Council's Licensing Policy states that premises 'must have suitable, appropriate authorised use under planning legislation' and that 'The Licensing Authority will not normally entertain an application for a licence unless the applicant can demonstrate that the premises have an appropriate planning consent.'
- 4.5 Statutory guidance issued by the Secretary of State under section 182 of the Licensing Act states that 'applications for premises licences for permanent commercial premises should normally be from businesses with planning consent for the property concerned'.
- 4.6 Members may be aware that as the sale of late night refreshment from takeaway restaurants has not previously been licensable, it has been possible for such premises to remain open for as long as they wished, subject to having appropriate planning permission. There are no planning restrictions relating to these premises.
- 4.7 As the Licensing Act 2003 defines late night refreshment as the provision of hot food after 11:00 p.m. Members may not impose any conditions, or hours restrictions that would have effect prior to this time.
- 4.8 No complaints have been received by the Public Protection and Housing Division regarding noise emanating from the premises.
- 4.9 The licensing objectives are:
 - a) the prevention of crime and disorder;
 - b) public safety;
 - c) the prevention of public nuisance; and
 - d) the protection of children from harm
- 4.10 Having regard to the representations received, Members may take any of the following steps for the promotion of the licensing objectives.

- 1) Grant the application without amendment
- 2) Grant the application with conditions, or amended conditions
- 3) Reject the application in full, or in part
- 4.11 Members are reminded that they must only consider those aspects of the licence application that are relevant to the representations received.

5. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

5.1 That Members consider the representations made by the applicant and interested parties and determine whether the licence should be granted and, if appropriate, what conditions, if any, should be attached.

We as a local residents association wish to object to the proposed licence of the premises above on the following grounds.

- Late night revellers leaving the premises causing a disturbance in and around the area shouting, swearing, urinating, banging car doors, vomiting, vandalism to homes and vehicles etc.
- Leaving part eaten meals strewn around on or around our property.
