Decision:	
<p>1) The Licensing Authority hereby approves the application for a new premises license for the provision of late night refreshments, subject to conditions consistent with the application and operating schedule submitted but with the following condition: -</p> <p>The premises shall close at 00.30 every evening with last orders taken at midnight.</p> <p>2) The Licensing Authority considered that the representations received from the responsible authorities demonstrated that if the premises were permitted to open any later this would reduce the quality of life for those living in the area due to the likelihood of nuisance and disturbance caused by customers visiting the premises any later.</p> <p>3) The Licensing Authority considered that the condition to restrict the hours of operation is necessary to promote the licensing objective relating to the prevention of public nuisance.</p> <p>For the above reasons, the application for a new premises license, for the provision of late night refreshments, is hereby approved.</p>
