<p>The Licensing Authority hereby approves the application for a new premises licence for the sale of alcohol.</p> <p>The Licensing Authority was not satisfied that the interested parties' representative, together with the interested parties present and the interested parties' written representations, disclosed strong enough reasons and evidence to demonstrate that the application would not promote the licensing objectives.</p> <p>In respect of the contention that the licensing objectives relating to the prevention of crime and disorder and the prevention of public nuisance would be undermined, it was noted that there had been no evidence presented on behalf of the police to demonstrate this.</p>
