## **Licensing Act 2003**

## **Procedure for Hearings**

Prior to the commencement of the meeting, a representative of the Democratic Services Section shall establish the identity of those present, who they represent and who intends, or wishes to speak.

- 1. The Chair's opening comments, including introduction of Members of subcommittee and officers present. Explanation of the decision to be considered.
- 2. Head of Public Protection and Housing outlines the application, any relevant representations and relevancy to Licensing Policy and statutory guidance.
- 3. Members ask any questions of the Head of Public Protection and Housing.
- 4. Applicants present their case (either personally or via legal representation) and introduces witnesses where appropriate.
- 5. Questions by Members to applicant and/or applicant's witness.
- 6. Representations by responsible bodies and/or interested parties and witnesses introduced where appropriate.
- 7. Questions by Members to responsible bodies/interested parties and/or their witnesses.
- 8. Parties may guestion and clarify issues raised with the consent of the Chair.
- 9. If required, responsible bodies/interested parties to be given opportunity to sum up.
- 10. If required, the applicant to be given opportunity to sum up.
- 11. Members to have the opportunity to clarify any points raised. The Chair shall ask whether all parties are satisfied they have said all they wish to.
- 12. Members to go into closed session to deliberate.
- 13. Chair informs parties of their decision, with reasons.

### 1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To consider an application for the review of a Premises Licence in respect of the Goldmine Public House, Catcote Road, Hartlepool.

## 2. BACKGROUND

2.1 Party requesting review: Cleveland Police

Premises to which application for review relates:

The Goldmine

Catcote Road Hartlepool

- 2.2 The current licence authorises the following activities: -
  - 1. Supply of Alcohol (On & Off Licence)
  - 2. Indoor Sporting Events
  - 3. Recorded Music
  - 4. Performance of Dance
  - 5. Provision of facilities for making Music
  - 6. Provision of facilities for Dancing

Monday to Thursday	1100 - 2300
Friday and Saturday	1100 – 0100
Sunday	1100 – 0000

7. Live Music Monday to Thursday 1100 – 2300 Friday to Sunday 1100 – 0000

8. Late Night Refreshment Friday and Saturday 2300 – 0100 Sunday 2300 – 0000

All the above activities may continue on Christmas Eve until 0000 and New Years Eve until 0200.

2.3 A copy of the Premises Licence is attached as Appendix I.

## 3. SUMMARY OF THE APPLICATION

3.1 The Police have requested a review of the Premises Licence on the following grounds: -

'The offence of the sale of alcohol outside the hours authorised by the premises licence was found being committed at 0140 hours on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> December 2005. The premises is on a residential estate and persons leaving at this hour would cause a nuisance to residents by way of noise being made as they leave the premises and make their way home through the estate.'

3.2 The Police have also provided the following additional information: -

'An anonymous call was made to the police reporting after hours drinking taking place at the premises. The police attended and found 23 people in the bar with fresh drinks. The Designated Premises Supervisor was present behind the bar of the premises at the time.

The till roll from the bar was seized by the police licensing officer and some 13 transactions of in the region of 23 alcoholic drinks had been made since the authorisation to sell alcohol to the public had ceased at midnight.'

3.3 A copy of the Application for Review is attached as Appendix II.

## 4. ISSUES

- 4.1 An application for the review of a licence is made under Section 51 of the Licensing Act 2003. The application must be made by either a Responsible Authority or Interested Party as defined by the Act. The Police are a Responsible Authority.
- 4.2 The application must also relate to at least one of the Act's 'licensing objectives'. These are: -
  - The prevention of crime and disorder;
  - Public safety;
  - The prevention of public nuisance; and
  - The protection of children from harm
- 4.3 The application has been advertised in the prescribed manner and no further representations have been received.
- 4.4 No complaints have been received by the Public Protection and Housing Division regarding noise emanating from the premises.
- 4.5 It is a requirement of the Licensing Act 2003, and a condition on the Premises Licence that alcohol sales may only be made at a time when there is a

- Designated Premises Supervisor (DPS) in respect of the premises and that the DPS holds a Personal Licence.
- 4.6 Members are advised that at the time of the incident referred to by the police in their representation the Designated Premises Supervisor was Lesley Ann McPartlin. Mrs McPartlin does not hold a Personal Licence. Formal legal action is being considered with regard to this contravention.
- 4.7 Following an application from Mrs McPartlin (at the Premises Licence Holder) on 6<sup>th</sup> January 2006, a new Designated Premises Supervisor/Personal Licence Holder has now been appointed for these premises.
- 4.8 Following consideration of the application and any relevant representations received, Members may take such steps as they consider necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives.
- 4.9 The steps are: -
  - To take no action:
  - To modify the conditions on the licence (this may include altering or omitting an existing condition or adding a new condition);
  - To exclude a licensable activity from the scope of the licence;
  - To remove the Designated Premises Supervisor;
  - To suspend the licence for a period not exceeding three months:
  - To revoke the licence.

## 5. RECOMMENDATIONS

5.1 That Members consider the representations made by the applicant and licence holder and determine what action, if any, should be taken.

## ANNEX 1 - Mandatory Conditions

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
  - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
  - at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

Every supply of alcohol made under the terms of this premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence

## ANNEX 2 - Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule


- All external doors and windows shall be kept closed when regulated entertainment is being provided except in the case of an emergency.
- 2. The licence holder or his representative shall conduct regular assessments of the noise coming from the premises on every occasion the premises are used for regulated entertainment and shall take steps to reduce the level of the noise where it is likely to cause a disturbance to local residents. A written record shall be made of those assessments in a log book kept for that purpose and shall include, the time and date of the checks, the person making them and the results including any remedial action.
- Live music shall only take place on the premises between the hours of 11:00hrs and 23:00hrs Monday to Thursday, 11:00hrs to 24:00hrs on a Friday, Saturday and Sunday. 11:00hrs to 24:00hrs Christmas Eve and 11:00hrs until 2:00am New Years Eve.
- Except with the prior written approval of the Licensing Authority and subject to any conditions which may be attached to such approval: -
  - (a) No special effects, naked flames, smoke production or any process creating a risk of fire, or the illusion of smoke or fire shall be used for the purpose of providing regulated entertainment on the premises.
  - (b) No explosives or highly flammable substances shall be brought into or used on the premises.
  - (c) No special effects shall be used or displays given on the premises, which consist of or include the use of lasers.

Applications for consent, giving detailed descriptions of the equipment to be used and details of the event, including dates and times must be made not less than 28 days before the date of the event.

- The licensee must ensure that the electrical socket outlets in the licensed premises, which are used for the purpose of providing licensed entertainment are protected by a residual current device being a 30 MA tripping circuit
- In the event of the fire alarm being activated a suitable relay must be provided so
  that the electrical power supply to all sound amplification system in the licensed
  premises must be immediately intercepted so that the alarm can be clearly heard
  in all parts of the licensed premises.
- Before any dancing takes place in the premises suitable facilities shall be provided for dancing and details of the same shall be agreed with the local authority.
- There shall be maintained on the premises at all times an adequate and appropriate supply of first aid equipment and materials for use by patrons.

- 9. Children will only be allowed in the premises when accompanied by an adult.
- Thirty minutes drinking up time shall follow the conclusion of the sale of alcohol.
- This licence is subject to such further conditions as are consistent with any
  restrictions imposed on the use of the premises for the existing licensable
  activities under the licence by virtue of the Children and Young Persons Act 1933.
