<p>1) The Licensing Authority hereby modifies the conditions of the premises licence for the provision of late night refreshment until 4.30am Thursday/Friday, Friday/Saturday and Saturday/Sunday and until 4.30am on Sunday/Bank Holiday Monday.</p> <p>2) The Licensing Authority was not satisfied that the Police Responsible Authority gave strong enough reasons and evidence to demonstrate that if these premises were to remain open any longer than their existing hours on these days that the licensing objectives relating to the prevention of crime and disorder and public safety would not be promoted.</p> <p>3) The Police Responsible Authority's main concerns related to crime and disorder and public nuisance as a whole and was not specific to the applicant premises.</p> <p>For the above reasons, the Licensing Authority modified the conditions.</p>
