<p>The Licensing Authority hereby approves the application for a new premises licence for the sale of alcohol.</p> <p>The Licensing Authority was not satisfied that the interested parties' representative and the interested parties' written representations, disclosed strong enough reasons and evidence to demonstrate that the application would not promote the licensing objectives.</p> <p>In respect of the contention that the licensing objectives relating to the prevention of crime and disorder, prevention of public nuisance and protection of children from harm it was noted that there had been no evidence presented which could demonstrate that those licensing objectives would be undermined if the application was granted.</p>
