Purpose of Report

To seek endorsement for the proposed Sustainable Construction Policy.

Issues for consideration by the Portfolio Holders

The Portfolio Holders had been provided with the report relating to Hartlepool Borough Council's intentions with regard to incorporating sustainability issues into its construction activities and introducing the role of sustainable construction in delivering Hartlepool's Community Strategy.

The Finance and Procurement Portfolio Holder asked what the cost implications would be to drive the policy forward. He was informed that although there were no actual figures outlined, initially construction costs could be higher but there would be significant savings made on future running costs, in addition to the reduction of CO_2 emissions which the Council must deliver.. The Portfolio Holder expressed concern that smaller local companies could suffer when

submitting quotes/tenders for work if they were unused to sustainable construction. He was informed that support would be offered by the Strategic Procurement Manager to smaller businesses within the procurement processes where they might be unable to compete singly they could be encouraged, to work together with other small businesses to achieve economies of scale.

Decision

The Portfolio Holders endorsed the Sustainable Construction Policy as a precursor to the development of a more comprehensive Sustainable Construction Strategy to be reported to a future joint meeting of the Portfolio Holders.
