Purpose of Report

To update the portfolio holder on proposals for change in the field of antisocial behaviour with an overview of possible implications for their implementation in Hartlepool.

Issues for Consideration

The Government was in the process of a consultation in relation to antisocial behaviour and the report gave an overview of the proposed changes, the main one being the replacement of Antisocial Behaviour Orders (ASBOs) with a Crime Prevention Injunction (CPI). Breach of a CPI would not result in a criminal record for juveniles. However, adults would be treated as being in contempt of court and subjected to fine or imprisonment and so would receive a criminal record. It was also proposed that the current Criminal Antisocial Behaviour Order (CRASBO) be replaced by a Criminal Behaviour Other Orders currently in place would be replaced by either Order. Community Protection Orders or Police Direction Powers. The report also detailed Community Triggers which were aimed at giving local people the power to shape the response to issues. It was proposed to extend the Direction Power to Police Community Support Officers who could require a person to leave an area for 24 hours. The Social Behaviour Manager was currently liaising with colleagues within the Council and Partners across the Safer Hartlepool Partnership to submit a co-ordinated response to this

consultation on behalf of the Safer Hartlepool Partnership.

Decision
