Decision:	
<p>The Licensing Authority considered an application by Cleveland Police as a responsible authority for the review of the premises licence for Rockies, 75 Church Street, Hartlepool relating to the licensing objective for the prevention of crime and disorder.</p> <p>Following the application for review the licence holder has formally amended the licence by reducing the trading hours from 0300 hours to 0200 hours and by adding further conditions to the licence including the use of a CCTV system, the employment of door supervisors and the introduction of a Challenge 21 system to prevent the sale of alcohol to children.</p> <p>In the circumstances the Licensing Authority did not consider it necessary under Section 52(3) Licensing Act 2003 to take any steps for the promotion of the licensing objectives under Section 52(4).</p>
