3. Members ask any questions of the Assistant Director, Regeneration and Planning (or representative)
4. Applicant for Review presents their case (either personally or via legal representation) and introduces witnesses where appropriate.
5. Questions by Members to applicant and/or applicant's witnesses.
6. Representations by responsible bodies and/or interested parties and witnesses introduced where appropriate.
7. Questions by Members to responsible bodies/interested parties and/or their witnesses.
8. Licence/Club Certificate holder presents their case (either personally or via legal representation) and introduces witnesses where appropriate.
9. Parties may question and clarify issues raised with the consent of the Chair.
10. If required, applicant/responsible bodies/interested parties to be given opportunity to sum up.
11. If required, the Licence /Club Certificate holder to be given opportunity to sum up.
12. Members to have the opportunity to clarify any points raised. The Chair shall ask whether all parties are satisfied they have said all they wish to.
13. Members to go into closed session to deliberate.
14. Chair informs parties of their decision, with reasons.

- 1.1 To consider an application for the variation of a premises licence in respect of The G.L.E. Bar (formerly RAOB Club), 58 Church Street, Hartlepool.

2. BACKGROUND

- 3.2 The applicant has also applied to extend the hours of operation of the premises as follows: -

Monday – Sunday 10:00 – 02:00

- 3.3 A copy of the application is attached as **Appendix II**.

- 3.4 The application has been advertised in the prescribed manner and two representations have been received – one from Cleveland Police and one from Hartlepool Borough Council's Environmental Health Team (see **Appendix III**).

- 3.5 The representation from Cleveland Police states that door supervisors should be engaged at the premises in order to promote the crime and disorder licensing objective. The representation from Environmental Health has raised concerns about potential noise nuisance from use of the balcony at the rear of the premises which is directly adjacent to the bedrooms of neighbouring flats.

4. **ISSUES**

- 4.1 As relevant representations have been received within the prescribed time period, a hearing must be held for Members to consider those representations (unless all parties agree a hearing is unnecessary).

- 4.2 Having regard to the representations received, Members may take any of the following steps for the promotion of the licensing objectives:

- i) To approve the application in its entirety
- ii) To approve the application in part - with or without the addition of further conditions
- iii) To reject the whole or part of the application

- 4.3 The licensing objectives are:

- i) The prevention of crime and disorder
- ii) Public safety
- iii) The prevention of public nuisance, and
- iv) The protection of children from harm

- 4.16 Members are reminded that they must only consider those aspects of the licence application that are relevant to the representations received.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS

- 5.1 That Members consider the representations made by the applicant and Responsible Authorities and determine what aspects, if any, of the proposed variation should be granted and, if appropriate, what conditions, if any, should be attached.

ANNEX 1 – Mandatory Conditions

1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
2. (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
 - (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children—
 - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to—
 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
 - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
 - (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on—
 - (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
 - (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
 - (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
3. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other

person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

4. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
5. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
6. The responsible person shall ensure that—
 - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures—
 - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
 - (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.



I refer to the above application to vary the premises licence and confirm that Cleveland Police wish to make representations for the following reasons:

As you will be aware, the application is to increase the hours for sale of alcohol and late night refreshment from midnight daily until hours to 02:00 hours daily and until 04.00 hours on a Bank Holiday.

This premises is situated in an area which already suffers from crime and disorder and drink related problems and historically, longer opening hours result in more alcohol related crime and disorder.

If the application is granted, Cleveland Police feel that the longer opening hours will undermine the crime and disorder and public safety objectives. However, if the following conditions are placed on the premises licence, this should assist with preventing the licensing objectives being undermined and Cleveland Police will withdraw representations made:

1. CCTV will be installed within the premises and will be in the form of a recordable system, capable of providing pictures of EVIDENTIAL QUALITY in all lighting conditions, particularly facial recognition. Cameras will encompass all ingress and egress to the premises, fire exits and all areas where the sale of alcohol occurs. Equipment MUST be maintained in good working order, be correctly timed and date stamped. All recordings must be kept in date order, numbered sequentially and kept for a period of 31 days. There must be at all times a member of staff on duty who is trained in the use of the equipment and upon receipt of a request for footage from a governing body, such as Cleveland Police or any other Responsible Authority, be able to produce the footage within a reasonable time, eg, within 24 hours routine or immediately if urgently required for investigation of a serious crime.

2. The recording equipment and tapes/discs shall be kept in a secure environment under the control of the DPS or other responsible named individual.

3. A minimum of two SIA Door Supervisors must be employed from 23.00 hours until closing each day.

In the event that these conditions are not agreed, Cleveland Police will provide further evidence.
