<p>The Licensing Authority hereby approves the application for a new premises licence for the supply of alcohol subject to agreed conditions with the Trading Standards responsible authority and Cleveland Police in respect of the provision of a CCTV system and a Challenge 21 policy</p> <p>The Licensing Authority was not satisfied that the interested party's written and oral representations disclosed strong enough reasons and evidence to demonstrate the application would not promote the licensing objectives relating to the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, the prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm</p> <p>For the above reasons the application for a new premises licence is hereby approved.</p>
