Decision:	
<p>The Licensing Sub Committee considered the application from Mr Hui Chen for a premises licence for the provision of late night refreshment until 11.30 p.m. Monday to Sunday in respect of the premises at 59a King Oswy Drive, Hartlepool.</p> <p>The Licensing authority received one letter of objection from an interested party on the grounds that additional noise and drunken behaviour and additional anti-social behaviour would occur if the premises were granted a licence.</p> <p>There were no objections from the Police or other responsible authorities.</p> <p>The Licensing Sub Committee heard from the applicant and considered his application. The Sub Committee also considered the letter of objection from the interested party but did not consider that it disclosed any evidence to show that the licensing objectives in relation to the prevention of crime and disorder and the prevention of public nuisance would be undermined if the application was granted.</p> <p>For the above reasons the Licensing Sub Committee hereby grants the application as submitted.</p>
