- iii) Wesley Square environmental improvements includes the removal of a small trip rail and replacement with a higher substantial railing together with the planting of new shrubs Cost £5,000

The report contained background information and outlined details of the proposed specification

The Portfolio Holder was advised that the specification had been prepared to incorporate all current and potential future requirements. The tender process would require select tenderers to attach a single cost for delivery of each module of the security contract as follows:

- Key-holding
- ii. Manned guarding (mobile and static)
- iii. Emergency call-out attendance/escort duties
- iv. Other duties as required

A tender advertisement had been issued toward the end of June 2006 and expressions of interest were due to be returned on 7<sup>th</sup> July 2006. Approval of a select tender list would be sought from Contract Scrutiny Panel on 24<sup>th</sup> July 2006 pending the next stage in the process.

A copy of the specification was appended to the report for the Portfolio Holder's attention. The continuation of the current contract was noted.

# 19. The Local Authorities (Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places) Regulations 2001 (Head of

Community Safety and Prevention)

## Type of decision

## **Purpose of report**

To seek approval to begin the process of consultation regarding the phasing out of existing Consumption of Intoxicating Liquor in Designated Places by elaw s and replacing these with a Designated Public Places Order under the Local Authorities (Alcohol Consumption in Designated Public Places) Regulations 2001.

## Issue(s) for consideration by Portfolio Holder

The report gave a brief background history of Designated Public Places Orders and outlined the proposed consultation action regarding the replacing of existing by elaw s. Details of locations of areas currently covered by Byelaw swere appended to the report for the Portfolio Holder's attention.

The Portfolio Holder requested that, as a second phase, additional areas such as shopping parades be considered for Designated Public Places Orders and that a separate report be submitted in due course.

The Portfolio Holder approved the commencement of the consultation process relating to replacing existing alcohol-banning byelaw swith Designated Public Places Order(s).
