Subject: OBJECTION TO TEMPORARY EVENT NOTICES – ZEUS, WHITBY STREET, HARTLEPOOL

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To consider an objection notice served by Cleveland Police in respect of nine Temporary Event Notices relating to proposed events to be held at Zeus, Whitby Street, Hartlepool.

2. BACKGROUND

3.1 Nine Temporary Event Notices have been submitted by Mr Darab Rezai in respect of the following: -

Duration of Events	1 hour 30 minutes

- 3.2 Copies of the Temporary Event Notices are attached as Appendices 1 9.
- 3.3 Mr Darab Rezai is the premises licence holder for the Zeus Nightclub which is currently licensed to supply alcohol until 03:00 hours and to provide regulated entertainment and late night refreshment until 03:20 hours 7 days a week. A copy of the current premises licence is attached as Appendix 10.

- 3.4 The Temporary Event Notice for 3rd & 4th November was received on 15th October 2012 and the others were received on 16th October.
- On 17th October 2012 a Notice of Objection was submitted by Cleveland
 Police in respect of all of the Event Notices (attached as Appendices 11 19) and an accompanying statement (Appendix 20).

4. ISSUES

- 4.1 Temporary Event Notices may be used for a maximum of 12 occasions per year with each occasion lasting no more than 7 days. The total number of days in any calendar year can be no more than 21. Mr Rezai will have used his full allocation of 21 days if every Notice currently under consideration is approved.
- 4.2 Temporary Event Notices may only be used for events where the maximum number of persons allowed at the premises at the same time is less than 500. Members may wish to ask how Mr Rezai will ensure that this requirement is met.
- 4.3 A Temporary Event Notice is not an application and does not require the approval or permission of the licensing authority unless an objection notice is served by either Cleveland Police or Hartlepool Borough Council's Environmental Health Department.
- 4.4 The Licensing Act states that the Police may serve an objection notice when they are satisfied that allowing the premises to be used in accordance with the Temporary Event Notice would undermine a licensing objective.
- 4.5 Cleveland Police have served objection notices stating that allowing the premises to be used in accordance with the Temporary Event Notices would undermine the Crime & Disorder and Public Safety licensing objectives.
- 4.6 As objection notices have been served the licensing authority is required to hold a hearing no later than 7 working days following receipt of the Police's objections and, having considered all relevant evidence, make a decision as to whether the proposed events may proceed and, if so, whether any conditions should be attached to them.
- 4.7 By virtue of Section 106A of the Licensing Act 2003 a licensing authority may choose to impose one or more conditions on a Temporary Event Notice where those conditions are also imposed on a premises licence that has effect for the same premises. The conditions that currently apply to the premises are contained in the premises licence that is attached as Appendix 10.
- 4.8 Having regard to the representations received, Members may choose to:

- i) Approve each Event Notice in its entirety
- ii) Approve each Event Notice with one or more conditions attached (see 4.7 above)
- iii) To reject one or more Event Notice
- 4.9 Members are reminded that they must only consider those aspects of each Event Notice that are relevant to the representations received.

5. **RECOMMENDATIONS**

5.1 That Members consider the representations made by the applicant and Cleveland Police and determine what aspects, if any, of the Temporary Event Notices should be approved and, if appropriate, what conditions, if any, should be attached.

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence-
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

- 2. In relation to the exhibition of films, the admission of children must be restricted in accordance with the classification designated by the British Board of film Classification (BBFC) or other authority designated by the Video Recordings Act 1984 for the film, or films being exhibited.
- 3. Each individual employed or otherwise engaged at the premises to carry out a security activity must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- 4. (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
 - (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children–
 - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to—

 (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or

discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);

- (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
- (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on—
 (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
 (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;

- (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
- 5. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
- 6. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.
- 7. (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
 - (2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
- 8. The responsible person shall ensure that-
 - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures—

 (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
 - (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

ANNEX 2 – Conditions consistent with the Operating Schedule

1 A CCTV system of a type and specification approved by Cleveland Police shall be installed, operated and maintained. It shall be operational during all trading hours and there shall be at least one camera permanently directed at each sales counter and bar so as to record all sales taking place.

Recordings shall be retained for a minimum of 28 days. Copies of recordings shall, **on request, be given immediately** to police officers or other authorised officers.

- 2 The DPS shall review the premises' CCTV on a daily basis in order to identify persons under the age of 18 who are attempting to buy alcohol or persons over the age of 18 buying on their behalf. A record of these checks shall be maintained and be available for inspection by police officers or other authorised officers.
- 3 Toughened glass and/or polycarbonate (plastic) must be used at all times at the premises.
- 4 There must be a minimum of four Security Industry Authority (SIA) registered door supervisors employed from 23:00 hours until closing (until the last customer leaves the premises) every Friday and Saturday and every Sunday commencing a Bank Holiday Monday.
- 5 The Premises Licence Holder shall operate and maintain an up-to-date Register of Refusals of Sale of Alcohol, indicating the date, time and reason for refusal which shall be made available for inspection by police officers or other authorised officers. The DPS shall check the book once a week ensuring it is complete and up to date. The DPS will sign the book each time it is checked.
- 6 A documented training scheme shall be introduced for all staff. The scheme shall be made available for inspection by police officers or other authorised officers.
- 7 The premises licence holder/DPS shall conduct weekly reviews with all members of staff and anyone else authorised to sell alcohol in order to reinforce the training and to promote best practice. A written record shall be made of the content of such reviews.
- 8 The premises licence holder/DPS shall maintain a file at the premises for each person authorised to sell alcohol. The file shall contain all training records for that person and copies of the record of each of the weekly reviews. The file is to be made available to police officers or other authorised officers upon request.
- 9 In order to promote the prevention of crime and disorder a manager shall patrol the premises, as is necessary and check the challenge 21 policy is being implemented.
- 10 The licence holder shall ensure that regular checks to toilets, bars and surrounding areas are made.

- 11 Music shall be maintained at a reasonable level and internal doors kept shut so as not to prevent public nuisance.
- 12 A challenge 21 Policy shall be operated at the premises at all times. Staff must check the identification of all persons who appear to be younger than 21 years old. This check shall be made by examining either a passport, photographic driving licence or a PASS approved proof of age card. No other forms of identification will be acceptable.
- 13 Publicity material notifying customers of the operation of the Challenge 21 scheme shall be displayed at the premises, including a Challenge 21 sign of at least A5 size at the point of sale. In addition, a similar notice shall be displayed at the entrance to the premises where it can clearly be seen and read.
- 14 Except with the prior written approval of the Licensing Authority and subject to any conditions which may be attached to such approval: -

(a) No special effects, naked flames, smoke production or any process creating a risk of fire, or the illusion of smoke or fire shall be used for the purpose of providing regulated entertainment on the premises.

(b) No explosives or highly flammable substances shall be brought into or used on the premises.

No special effects shall be used or displays given on the premises, which consist of or include the use of lasers.

Applications for consent, giving detailed descriptions of the equipment to be used and details of the event, including dates and times must be made not less than 28 days before the date of the event.

- 15 The licensee must ensure that the electrical socket outlets in the licensed premises, which are used for the purpose of providing licensed entertainment are protected by a residual current device being a 30 MA tripping circuit.
- 16 In the event of the fire alarm being activated a suitable relay must be provided so that the electrical power supply to all sound amplification system in the licensed premises must be immediately intercepted so that the alarm can be clearly heard in all parts of the licensed premises.
- 17 There shall be maintained on the premises at all times an adequate and appropriate supply of first aid equipment and materials for use by patrons.
- 18 The premises shall adopt and implement a drugs policy and incorporate a secured drugs seizure box of a type approved by Cleveland Police.
- 19 All external doors and windows shall be kept closed when regulated entertainment is being provided except in the case of an emergency, accepting that external doors that permit access to the public in the normal course of operation may be open only to allow access and egress.

Mr Darab Rezai of the above premises has applied for Temporary Event Notice on 3rd and 4th November to allow the sale of alcohol until 04.00 hours and all other licensable activities until 04.20 hours. Cleveland Police give notice of objection that if granted, it will undermine both the Crime and Disorder and Public Safety objectives. The reasons for objection are due to the following incidents which have occurred recently:

28th July 2012, Section 18 Assault

Victim is in Zeus at approximately 01.00hrs on dance floor when he is punched to his face area by male Victim sustained a fractured jaw as a result of being assaulted.

4th August 2012, Section 47 Assault

Whilst victim is in Zeus, she is approached by a known female. An altercation occurs and suspect threatens the victim with violence. As a result, the victim leaves the venue but she is followed by the suspect outside the venue, and is assaulted. The victim is dragged to the ground, punched repeatedly to the head area, and is bitten to the lower calf area of her leg. Victim sustained injuries of bite with broken skin and bruising to leg, bruising to inside lip area, bump to bridge of nose and bruising to left forearm.

25th August 2012 Section 39 Assault

Whilst victim is in Zeus, she is approached by unknown female who punches her to top of her head area. Suspect is ejected from Zeus but moments later, another large fight starts within Zeus and the victim from initial assault gets caught up in. The Victim is amongst others who are ejected from Zeus, whilst she is stood near the entrance of Zeus. The suspect approaches the victim and punches her to the face. To prevent further disorder, the victim is allowed back in Zeus. However, whilst in Zeus the victim passes out and ambulance is called. The victim is taken to hospital where it was established that she sustained bump to head and left black eye.

1st September 2012 Assault.

Whilst victim is Zeus, he is assaulted by ex partner and family members.

Victim confirms that there has been an altercation/scuffle whilst inside Zeus. Where he was punched and kicked, Victim would like the assailant warned regarding his conduct towards him.

8th September 2012, Drunk & Disorderly, Assault Police.

Whilst police are on patrol on Church Street, taxi driver informs police of a fight outside Zeus on Whitby Street.

Police attend and find numerous persons males/females involved in disturbance; police separate both parties to ascertain what has occurred. Group of females stating they have been assaulted on dance floor in Zeus.

One male involved unknown at the time if responsible for assault becomes aggressive and is arrested for Drunk & Disorderly, whilst been restrained struggles and assaults police officer by kicking officer in upper thigh area of right leg, causing bruising to leg.

Cleveland Police are of the opinion that historically, longer opening hours result in more alcohol related anti social behaviour. If the TEN's are granted, this will undoubtedly lead to more alcohol related incidents.

Suspect is ejected from Zeus but moments later, another large fight starts within Zeus and the victim from initial assault gets caught up in. The Victim is amongst others who are ejected from Zeus, whilst she is stood near the entrance of Zeus. The suspect approaches the victim and punches her to the face. To prevent further disorder, the victim is allowed back in Zeus. However, whilst in Zeus the victim passes out and ambulance is called. The victim is taken to hospital where it was established that she sustained bump to head and left black eye.

1st September 2012 Assault.

Whilst victim is Zeus, he is assaulted by ex partner and family members.

Victim confirms that there has been an altercation/scuffle whilst inside Zeus. Where he was punched and kicked, Victim would like the assailant warned regarding his conduct towards him.

8th September 2012, Drunk & Disorderly, Assault Police.

Whilst police are on patrol on Church Street, taxi driver informs police of a fight outside Zeus on Whitby Street.

Police attend and find numerous persons males/females involved in disturbance; police separate both parties to ascertain what has occurred. Group of females stating they have been assaulted on dance floor in Zeus.

One male involved unknown at the time if responsible for assault becomes aggressive and is arrested for Drunk & Disorderly, whilst been restrained struggles and assaults police officer by kicking officer in upper thigh area of right leg, causing bruising to leg.

Cleveland Police are of the opinion that historically, longer opening hours result in more alcohol related anti social behaviour. If the TEN's are granted, this will undoubtedly lead to more alcohol related incidents.

Mr Darab Rezai of the above premises has applied for Temporary Event Notice on the above dates to allow the sale of alcohol until 04.00 hours and all other licensable activities until 04.20 hours. Cleveland Police give notice of objection that if granted, it will undermine both the Crime and Disorder and Public Safety objectives. The reasons for objection are due to the following incidents which have occurred within the last eight weeks:

28th July 2012, Section 18 Assault

Victim is in Zeus at approximately 01.00hrs on dance floor when he is punched to his face area by male Victim sustained a fractured jaw as a result of being assaulted.

4th August 2012, Section 47 Assault

Whilst victim is in Zeus, she is approached by a known female. An altercation occurs and suspect threatens the victim with violence. As a result, the victim leaves the venue but she is followed by the suspect outside the venue, and is assaulted. The victim is dragged to the ground, punched repeatedly to the head area, and is bitten to the lower calf area of her leg. Victim sustained injuries of bite with broken skin and bruising to leg, bruising to inside lip area, bump to bridge of nose and bruising to left forearm.

1. I am a serving police officer with Cleveland Police. I am currently stationed with the Hartlepool District Alcohol Licensing Unit.

2. Part of my role is to monitor licensed premises within Hartlepool, review any new applications for Temporary Event Notices, and assess the impact caused by any such applications, which will affect the four licensing objectives.

3. This statement is in relation to applications by Darab REZAI who is the owner/Designated Premises Supervisor of Zeus Bar, 17 Whitby Street, Hartlepool for a number of Temporary Event Notices to open until 4.30am over numerous dates in November 2012 and December 2012.

4. On 17th October 2012, Cleveland Police gave notice that Chief Constable of Cleveland Police is satisfied that the exceptional circumstances of these applications are such that granting them will undermine the crime prevention and public safety objectives.

5. There have been previous representations made against a Temporary Event Notice from Mr Rezai for Zeus Bar on the 31st August 2012 on the same grounds (the application was withdrawn) and on 24th September 2012 (which was allowed). Copies of these are exhibited as AT/1 and AT/2 for the purposes of these objections. Despite the fact that Mr Rezai has met with police to address concerns associated with the premises (resulting in an Action Plan) Cleveland Police feel it far too soon to assess the effectiveness of the Action Plan and other measures Mr Rezai has put in place.

- 6. The following are all incidents that have occurred in or around the premise of Zeus Bar in the past 11 weeks alone. They are not the only incidents to have occurred connected with Zeus Bar, but they are all instances of violent crime.
- 7. On Saturday 28th July 2012, at approximately 01:00 hours, a male was in Zeus Bar on a night out socializing and having a drink. Whilst the male was on the dance-floor dancing and enjoying himself, he was approached by another male. Seemingly, without provocation the other male has punched the victim in the face. The victim did not know the male and left the premises with a bloody nose and holding his face. On seeking medical treatment, the victim discovered he had a fractured jaw because of the altercation.
- 8. On Saturday 4th August 2012, at around 03:00 hours a female (1) was on a night out with friends, seeing what had been a good night out, in Zeus Bar. She is approached by a

female (2) she knows and an argument starts over a mutual friend. To avoid any conflict female (1) leaves the premises. Female (2) follows her out of the premises and approaches the victim (female 1). Female (2) drags the victim to the ground and proceeds to punch her several times to the head. She is also bitten on the lower calf of her right leg before being dragged off by a member of the public. As a result of the attack, the victim sustained broken skin and bruising from the bite, bruising to her lip and a bump to the bridge of her nose and bruising to her left arm.

9. On Saturday 25th August 2012 at around 01:10 hours, the victim is in Zeus on a night out with friends, when she is approached by an unknown female, who punches her to top of her head. The suspect is ejected from Zeus. Moments later another large fight starts within Zeus, where the victim from the initial assault is caught up in it. The victim is ejected from Zeus along with other people. Whilst the victim is stood near the entrance of Zeus, the suspect approaches the victim and punches her to the face. To prevent an escalation the victim is allowed back in Zeus. In Zeus the victim passes out, ambulances are called and the victim is taken to hospital. The victim sustained a bump to head and her left eye was blackened.

10. On Saturday 1st September 2012 before 03:30 hours, when the incident is reported the victim is in Zeus enjoying a night out. He is approached by his ex-partner and her family members. He is punched and kicked by them whilst inside the premises. Whilst he did not

wish to make a complaint because of personal reasons, the fact is the assault did happen and it happened inside the premises.

11. On Saturday 8th September 2012 at 02:30 hours, officers were informed by a passing taxi driver that there was a group fighting outside Zeus Bar, Whitby Street. When officers attended, they find a group of males and females outside the Zeus Bar causing a disturbance. Police separate them and try to ascertain what has happened. A group of females allege that they have been assaulted on the dance-floor in Zeus Bar. One unknown male became aggressive when spoken to and was arrested as being Drunk and Disorderly. Whilst restrained by police officers the male lashed out at another officer kicking her in the upper thigh area of her right leg causing bruising to the area.

12. In themselves, the incidents show that there have been violent alcohol related occurrences at the bar. Moreover, the premises were failing in their duty to inform responsible authorities that these incidents were occurring and were failing to deal proactively with the incidents. Mr Rezai has been putting actions into place to help alleviate these situations and has been in contact with us to this end. However, we consider that these actions should be given time to bed and show over a significant and consistent period of time that they can be effective in helping the issues. As Mr Rezai is now asking to supply alcohol until 04:00 hours and close at 04:30 hours (half an hour after all the other alcohol on license premises are closed), this is now well in to the period when we historically encounter the most problems of Anti-social behaviour and violent crime in the
