HADJ'S MINI MARKET, 134 YORK ROAD,

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To consider an application for a new premises licence in respect of Hadj's Mini Market, 134 York Road, Hartlepool.

2. SUMMARY OF APPLICATION

- 2.1 Applicant: Mr Nouredin Hadj Kaddour

Premises: 134 York Road
Hartlepool

- 2.2 The applicant has applied for a licence for the off sales of alcohol 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Sales of alcohol between 2300 hours and 0700 hours would be from a hatch.

A copy of the application is attached as **Appendix 1**.

Street view images of the property (shown as an empty grey building) are attached as **Appendix 2**.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 The application has been advertised in the prescribed manner and six representations have been received: One from Cleveland Police
- 3.2 (**Appendix 3**), one from a local solicitor, Tilly, Bailey & Irvine (**Appendix 4**), three from Hartlepool residents (**Appendices 5-7**) and one from the Council's Trading Standards & Licensing Manager (**Appendix 8**).
- 3.3 Collectively the representations refer to the potential detrimental impact that the 24 hour sale of alcohol would have on the Licensing Act's licensing objectives.
- 3.4 The representation from the Trading Standards & Licensing Manager highlights Hartlepool Borough Council's current Licensing Policy which details the Council's position on late night opening.

- 3.5 Several of the representations refer to this property's close proximity to other late licensed premises in the area. These premises are: -

In addition to the above, there is a pending application to extend the operating hours for Popworld, Victoria Road to 3:00 a.m.

4. **ISSUES**

- 4.1 As relevant representations have been received, a hearing must be held for Members to consider the application (unless all parties agree a hearing is unnecessary).
- 4.2 The representation from Cleveland Police states that the property's close proximity to the Night Time Economy may lead to issues of nuisance, crime and disorder and public safety.
- 4.3 The representation from Tilly, Bailey & Irvine states that there is already alcohol related nuisance in the vicinity and that the granting of a 24 hour licence would add to the cumulative impact of crime & disorder, public safety and nuisance in the area.
- 4.4 The representations from local residents collectively refer to the potential for increased nuisance and crime & disorder.
- 4.5 The representation from the Council's Trading Standards & Licensing Manager highlights paragraph 5.14 of the Council's current Licensing Policy which states: -

'The licensing authority does not accept that longer opening hours have been a benefit to Hartlepool but rather that they place an undue and unnecessary strain on the local transport infrastructure, Accident & Emergency services and law enforcement agencies and creates a nuisance for those residents who are affected by the general operation of a premises or from revellers returning home during the early hours.'

Shops, stores and supermarkets will in general be licensed to provide sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises at any time when the retail outlet is open for shopping but licences for before 9:00 a.m. or after 10:00 p.m. in residential areas will generally be refused. In addition, licence applications for the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises for before 9:00 a.m. or after 11:30 p.m. in residential areas will generally be refused.

In non residential areas applications for licences to allow the sale of alcohol or the supply of late night refreshment beyond 2:00 a.m. will normally be refused subject to relevant representations being received.'

4.6 Having regard to the representations received, Members may take any of the following steps for the promotion of the licensing objectives:

- i) To approve the application in its entirety
- ii) To approve the application in part - with or without the addition of further conditions
- iii) To reject the whole or part of the application

4.7 Members are reminded that they must only consider those aspects of the licence application that are relevant to the representations received.

5. RECOMMENDATIONS

5.1 That Members consider the representations made by the applicant and the objectors and determine what aspects, if any, of the application should be granted and, if appropriate, what conditions, if any, should be attached.

Could you please accept this as our formal notification that Cleveland Police will be objecting to the application of Nouredin Hadj Kaddour for a licensed premises (Hadj's Mini Market) at 134 York Road, Hartlepool.

We are objecting on the grounds of Public Nuisance, Crime and Disorder and Public Safety. The positioning of the premise means it will be very close to the Night Time Economy which is centred on the Victoria Road/York Road/Avenue Road area. The main concerns are that after a night of drinking, for some until 4am, people will be able to take a short walk to the premise where they will be able to buy more alcohol which they will then be able to drink on the way home. This will have an affect not just on the immediate area, but on taxi drivers who may pick these people up, or people living on the path home.

Another major concern is there is a minority of people who are bent on causing issues and if they are refused entry to all of the on-licensed premises it is a short trip to 134 York Road, where they will be able to purchase whatever alcohol they like. Many of these people will not present as being drunk but the premises know from experience who and what look for.

Being able to buy alcohol such as short distance from the Night Time Economy could also present problems of violence and disorder. Takeaways close to and in the Night Time Economy area suffer from incidents and they do not supply alcohol only food. The takeaways are also required to supply door staff if they are open past midnight on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays preceding Bank Holidays and any Bank Holidays, and even with this they will get the occasional problem.

Hartlepool Councils licensing policy states that it will not normally allow new premise Licences past 2am and I believe this policy has merit and ensures that issues are kept to a minimum. I do not consider that this premise would be an exception to this policy.

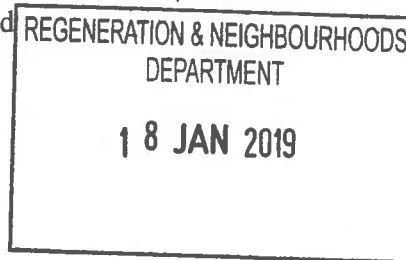

On behalf of Tilly Bailey & Irvine LLP, I object to the above application. We have two solicitor's offices directly opposite the applicant and one beside.

I understand that the applicant's shop is open twenty four hours a day currently and that at night, he sells produce through some form of hatch. Already, a disgruntled customer has broken his widow as a result of a dispute.

Sadly, people do consume alcohol to excess in public near the Hartlepool Library. They sit on walls there, drink alcohol and cause a nuisance. Sometimes they come to our doorway and sit and drink alcohol there and have to be asked to leave.

It is for these reasons with regret that I must object. I submit that the provision of a twenty four hour licencing outlet will add to the cumulative impact and therefore, not ensure the promotion of the licencing objectives; particularly, the general impact of alcohol related crime and disorder.

My objections are:-

1. The application will add to the cumulative impact already in existence in the area and thereby, will not satisfy the objective of preventing crime and disorder in an area where the same is already in existence.
2. The application will add to the cumulative impact already in existence in the area and thereby, will not satisfy the objective of securing public safety in an area where street drinking is inappropriate.
3. The application will add to the cumulative impact already in existence in the area and thereby, will not satisfy the objective of preventing public nuisance in an area where drinking already has an impact on the public.

We write in connection to the above application as Local Residents of over 10 years in the Victoria Ward and wish to lodge our representation to the application on the grounds that, if granted:

- Crime and disorder would be adversely affected
- Public nuisance would be exacerbated
- Public safety would be threatened
- Protection of children from harm could be compromised

The Victoria Ward has more than its fair share of problems including antisocial behavior and misuse of drugs and alcohol. This is evidenced by the Tees Valley Ward Profiles provided by the Tees Valley Combined Authority which outlines the deprivation evident in the Victoria Ward.

The application makes reference under section M c) Public Safety to 'instant access to police'. It would be interesting see how this would be achieved at a time when the Chief Constable, Mike Veale, has publicly declared that, due to the austerity placed upon Cleveland Police, he has insufficient officers available to deal with current demand. As evidenced recently on national news which stated that on some nights there are as few as 10 police officers to cover the whole of the Hartlepool district.

We believe that the 24 hours availability of alcohol will lead to further antisocial behaviour and drinking in the streets and park area of Thornton Street. It will increase litter and make the area in which we live more intimidating.

Although access by vehicle could be accommodated by its location, we believe it will lead to an increase in footfall up and down the local streets throughout the night by often noisy drunken individuals (who even if refused service will flock to the shop in an attempt to be served). This will create a disturbance to local residents.

Children in the area already manage to gain illegal access to both alcohol and cigarettes and this establishment would just provide a further outlet. Whilst we understand that challenge will be made to ensure no one underage is served, it must also be accepted that adults are buying products on behalf of children some which are very young.

There are many other outlets already available to buy alcohol at various times of the day and we really can see no benefit to the people of the Victoria Ward and Hartlepool in general to granting this licence. The only beneficiary would be the applicant by way of profit.

We find it inconceivable that in the present environment and the objections detailed above, that Hartlepool Borough Council could allow an establishment of this type the option of serving alcohol 24 hours a day.

We have copied in our Ward Councillors who have in the past been very supportive and understand the difficulties of the Ward.

This representation is made on behalf of Hartlepool Borough Council in its role as licensing authority and in respect of an application for a new premises licence for the above named property.

Hartlepool Borough Council's current Statement of Licensing Policy (published in 2016) states the following: -

5.14 The licensing authority does not accept that longer opening hours have been a benefit to Hartlepool but rather that they place an undue and unnecessary strain on the local transport infrastructure, Accident & Emergency services and law enforcement agencies and creates a nuisance for those residents who are affected by the general operation of a premises or from revellers returning home during the early hours.

Shops, stores and supermarkets will in general be licensed to provide sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises at any time when the retail outlet is open for shopping but licences for before 9:00 a.m. or after 10:00 p.m. in residential areas will generally be refused. In addition, licence applications for the supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises for before 9:00 a.m. or after 11:30 p.m. in residential areas will generally be refused.

In non residential areas applications for licences to allow the sale of alcohol or the supply of late night refreshment beyond 2:00 a.m. will normally be refused subject to relevant representations being received.

In addition, Chapter 6 of the Statement of Licensing Policy also establishes a Cumulative Impact Policy for the area in which 134 York Road is situated. Para 6.8 of the Policy states: -

6.8 A Cumulative Impact Policy creates a rebuttable presumption that applications for new premises licences, club premises certificates or material variations will normally be refused, if relevant representations are received.

I am a serving police officer with Cleveland Police. I am currently stationed with the Licensing Support Unit at Middlesbrough Police HQ.

Part of my role as a licensing support officer is to monitor on and off licensed premises within Hartlepool and Stockton districts ensuring that they are trading within the spirit of the four licensing objectives. We will ask that they will not have an adverse affect on the surrounding community or have a negative impact on Crime & Disorder, Public Safety or Public Nuisance objectives and will Prevent Harm to Children. We will only object to new applications or variations on existing licences if we consider that it may cause issues for the premise or have a negative impact on any of the four main licensing objectives.

This statement is in response to a new application for an off-licensed premises licence by Nouredin Hadj KADDOUR for a premise at 134 York Road, Hartlepool which is to be called Hadj's Minimarket. Cleveland Police object to the application because we consider that a new premise licence which will effectively make the premises a 24 hour off licence will

have a negative impact on the Licensing Objectives mainly Preventing Crime and Disorder, Public Safety and Protection of Children.

The premise is situated on York Road, and is only approximately 300 meters away from the top of Victoria Road where there a number of late night venues which have licenses to supply alcohol until at least 2am (some until 4am) and where the large proportion of our Night Time Economy issues occur. In the past three years we have reviewed two of the premises on Victoria Road due to the issues there. The premises will also be less than 200 yards from the nearest on licensed premises, Changes, 100 York Road, which has a midnight licence.

There are a number of late night takeaways in the area especially on York Road. Those that are open past midnight are required to have door supervisors with up to date SIA registration and licences provided by a reputable company on their doors until the premises is closed on Friday nights, Saturday nights and Sundays preceding Bank Holidays. Even with this precaution they will still occasionally have issues and they do not sell alcohol.

During the last six months there have been 18 incidents reported to the police of either violence or disorder connected to alcohol. Only one of these incidents happened prior to 23:00 hours (11pm). All of the others would impact at the time when the application states the shop will be closed and the hatch opened for alcohol sales. We firmly believe that the sale of alcohol for off site drinking will exacerbate these issues and could put the

employees/owners of the premises and the general public at risk of being victims of violence or disorder.

I have detailed below a precis of these incidents to show the issues that the Night Time economy and associated businesses suffer.

On Sunday 29th July 2018 at around 23:56 hours a mother contacted Cleveland Police to report her daughter had been assaulted in one of the takeaways but she was unsure where. It is later ascertained it was one of the takeaways on York Road. The female was waiting outside one of the takeaways when a male became aggressive towards her. The male began to pull her hair and punched her in the face. The female managed to get away, scared and shaken and return home. A suspect was identified but the complaint was not taken any further. I will refer to this as Incident 1.

On Monday 30th July 2018 at around 02:53 hours Cleveland Police attended York Road and stopped to speak to a male who looked agitated. He was shouting and swearing at a male across the road. The officer could see the male and female stood at the bus stop were distressed by the males actions and other members of the public passing by were also nervous of coming any where near the male. The officer asked the male on numerous occasions to calm down and stop swearing. The male refused and began to swear at the officer and goaded him. The male was arrested under Section 5 Public Order Act 1986 and received a fixed penalty ticket when he had sobered up later in the morning. I will refer to this as Incident 2.

On Monday 6th August 2018 at around, 01:39 hours a male is enjoying a night out with friends. They come out of one of the on-licensed premises on Victoria Road, Hartlepool when another male approaches. Without warning he punches the victim in the face causing him to fall to the ground where the victim loses consciousness. The assailant makes off in the direction of York Road. Unfortunately the victim and his friends are unable to identify the assailant. I will refer to this as incident 3

On Sunday 19th August 2018 at around 20:36 hours a call was made to police to advise that an elderly male had been assaulted on South Road, Hartlepool by a younger male. Independent witnesses state that the younger male ran up to the victim and hit the victim over the head without warning or provocation. Fortunately the victim was not seriously injured. The assailant was later arrested for the assault, carrying a bladed article and criminal damage and has since been charged. I will refer to this as Incident 4.

On Saturday 1st September 2018 at around 01:37 hours, report to Cleveland police from one of the victims, that she and her sister have been out for the night, when she has been attacked by her boyfriend's ex-girlfriend. This had happened at a premises on Victoria Road, Hartlepool. Both the female and her sister have been assaulted suffering scratches and marks to the neck. The victim would not take the complaint further. I will refer to this as Incident 5.

On Thursday 18th October 2018 at around, 01:15 hours a female was out with her friend. Whilst in a premise in Victoria Road, Hartlepool, they both went to the toilet when her friend got in to an altercation with a female who knocked her friend to the ground. When the victim went to help her friend up, a male punched her in the jaw. Fortunately there were no serious injuries but the victim was shaken by the incident. No charges were brought to the male. I will refer to this as incident 6.

On Saturday 20th October 2018, at around 01:41 hours, a male victim reported to the police that he had been hit over the back of the head with a bottle in the beer garden of a licensed premise on Victoria Road, Hartlepool. The victim could not identify the assailant and fortunately suffered no serious injuries. I will refer to this as Incident 7.

On Saturday 10th November 2018, during the early hours (no definitive time given), the female victim was enjoying a night out with a friend. While in a licensed premises on Victoria Road, Hartlepool, she suffered an unprovoked attack from another female, resulting in clumps of hair being pulled out and her one her eyelids and tear ducts being injured which required medical treatment. The female would not take the complaint forward so no charges were brought. I will refer to this as Incident 8.

On Sunday 11th November 2018 at around 03:25 hours, a female was on a night out in a licensed premise on Victoria Road, Hartlepool, when a female known to her approaches her and without provocation throws a drink over her. The female assailant then grabs the

victims hair and pulls it causing pain. The victim suffers no permanent injury and the assailant was not identified. I will refer to this as Incident 9.

The female was identified as the aggressor and had caused scratches and reddening to the male's neck. The male did not wish to take the matter any further and the female was taken home away from the area. I will refer to this as Incident 10.

On Saturday 15th December 2018 at around 01:30 hours, the male victim was out with his friends in a licensed premises on Victoria Road, Hartlepool. The male victim went to the toilets and without provocation or warning was set about by a group of 3-4 males. The male victim suffered bruising and swelling to his eye and cheek which required medical attention. The assailants could not be identified. I will refer to this as Incident 11.

On Sunday 16th December 2018, at around 00:35 hours, ambulance control notified the police that there was a large scuffle outside one of the licensed premises on Victoria Road, Hartlepool, between different groups. The injured female was hit by a bottle causing a large lump and bruising to the front of her head which required medical attention. The assailant could not be identified. I will refer to this as Incident 12.

The Female victim has been out with friends on Tuesday 18th December 2018 around 23:29 hours. The female victim has been in the beer garden of a licensed premise on South Road, Hartlepool, when she has been approached by the female assailant who without warning or provocation has grabbed hold of the victim's neck. The victim has managed to free herself but has sustained cuts and scratches to her neck. The assailant could not be identified. I will refer to this as Incident 13.

A manager of a licensed premises has contacted police on Saturday 22nd December 2018 at around 04:09 hours. They have found a male unconscious on the ground to the side of the premise off Victoria Road, Hartlepool. The male comes round before ambulance can attend and refuses any help. He states he was attacked by a single male who punched him to the side of the head, unprovoked and that is the last he remembers. The assailant could not be identified. I will refer to this as Incident 14.

On Friday 28th December 2018 at around 23:40 hours the female victim and her sister were on York Road when 2 unknown females have approached them and without provocation, have assaulted them. As a result of the assault the female victim has sustained a sprained and bruised ankle and an injury to her right thumb and one of her fingers. The suspects could not be traced. I will refer to this as Incident 15.

A male has been out drinking on Sunday 30th December 2018 at around 01:50 hours, when he has been attacked by unknown persons. The male has sustained a deep laceration to his head almost to the skull as a result of the attack which required hospital treatment. As

On police arrival males were still fighting in the middle of the road. One of the males punches the other causing the victim to fall to the floor where the other male continues to punch him while he is on the ground. The police pull the aggressive male away, who continues to be verbally aggressive towards the victim and police. While trying to restrain the male by putting him in hand cuffs the male head-butts one of the police officers in the forehead. The male has been arrested and charged. I will refer to this as Incident 17.

On Sunday 6th January 2019 at approximately 23:57 hours the door staff at a licensed premise on York Road, Hartlepool, escort a male out for being aggressive towards and abusive to other customers. The male takes exception to this and tries to start a fight with the door staff, shouting racist slurs at one of the door staff. Due to his aggression and unpredictability the door staff restrain the male on the floor until police attend and the male is arrested. The male continues to be aggressive with the police The male is arrested and charged with Racially Aggravated Public Order. I will refer to this as Incident 18.

These incidents have happened within the Night Time Economy often at premises which have door staff and yet they have still happened. Some have happened at Takeaways who

There are enough incidents without the fear of incidents spreading out of the NTE area due to alcohol being consumed on the way home.
