1. TYPE OF DECISION/APPLICABLE CATEGORY

2. PURPOSE OF REPORT

2.1 To provide details of the Economic Growth Team's 2023 business events programme.

3. BACKGROUND

- 3.1 To support the delivery of the recently approved Inclusive Growth Strategy, the Economic Growth Team will be organising a number of events to engage with local businesses.
- 3.2 The events will cover the priorities highlighted in the Inclusive Growth Strategy's ten point plan, primarily the business support interventions, inclusive of specific priority sectors such as the creative industries.
- 3.3 The proposed events will cover a variety of themes, including finance, skills and recruitment, digital marketing, intellectual property, doing business with the council, international trade, and boosting the visitor economy.
- 3.4 The events will raise awareness of support services available locally, in the Tees Valley and through national initiatives.

4. PROPOSALS

4.1 The table below summarises the Economic Growth Team's proposed events programme for 2023.

- 4.2 The events will be organised in partnership with external support agencies such as Tees Valley Business, Teesside University, Hartlepool College of Further Education, Hartlepool Sixth Form College, the Department of International Trade, start-up support agencies and other funding organisations, depending on the event themes.
- 4.3 Internal council teams such as Learning and Skills and procurement, will also be involved in the planning and delivery of events.
- 4.4 The events will target a variety of businesses ranging from start-ups to those which are more established and may be looking to grow or seeking support with a particular issue e.g. funding, training and skills, or marketing.
- 4.5 Although the below list of event is currently accurate, some specific details are still to be confirmed and therefore the programme is subject to minor changes. There may be also opportunities throughout the year to delivery further events.
