Subject:	HIGHWAY PLANING AND RESURFACING TENDER

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

To advise members of the shortlisting process carried out for a Highway Surfacing Partnership and to seek approval to use the shortlist to tender for a new term contract.

2. BACKGROUND

In the financial year 2004/2005, a significant amount of work was carried out to shortlist four companies specialising in highway planing and resurfacing for a potential three way partnership between Hartlepool Borough Council (as Clients), the Technical Services Joint Venture Company (as Consultants) and the resurfacing company (as Contractors for resurfacing). The longlisting involved carrying out Technical, Financial and Health and Safety analyses and all successful companies then attended a shortlisting interview prior to selection.

Unfortunately, the process did not continue into the year 05/06 due to uncertainty with respect to the JVC as well as a restructure of the Technical Services Division, which took Highway Services into Neighbourhood Management. Changes in personnel and other priorities have also prevented this development from being concluded.

It is now clear that a partnership is not going to be possible in the way that it was originally intended, however it is still possible to proceed with the four shortlisted companies to a tender for a traditional style planing and resurfacing annual contract. This will save the expense of repeating the shortlisting exercise and will make use of the work carried out to date and will make best use of the circumstances.

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3. RECOMMENDATIONS

That Contract Scrutiny Panel approve the use of the existing shortlist of contractors for the tendering of the new annual planing and resurfacing contract.
