In 2020 the Council granted an easement permitting foul water drainage to run across its land north of the Manor Park

development in Hart village. The drainage pipe has subsequently been installed and connected to the main drain that runs under

the Council's land.

The developers have now requested that the Council be party to a Section 104 agreement to be concluded between the developer, landowner, Council and Northumbrian Water. This will allow Northumbrian Water to adopt the drainage pipe. It is proposed to agree to a be party to the agreement. The

agreement doe not impose any financial liability on the Council, but does prevent building over the pipe and protective strip and

prevents change of use of the affected land.

These aspects were accepted in and compensation received for

them in the grant of the deed of easement.
